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this book presents the proceedings of the 18th international conference on graphic design in architecture ega 2020 focusing on heritage including architectural and graphic heritage as well as the graphics of heritage consisting of two parts representation and analysis and concept and creation this second volume gathers selected contributions on topics ranging from graphic representation to the graphic presentation of ideas i e artistic creation to bridge the gap between graphic heritage and the graphics of heritage given its scope this volume will appeal to architectural and graphic designers artists and engineers providing them with extensive information on new

methods and a source of inspiration for future research and interdisciplinary collaborations

beginning in 1990 thousands of spanish speakers emigrated to japan a cultural history of spanish speakers in japan focuses on the intellectuals literature translations festivals cultural associations music bolero tropical music and pop including reggaeton dance flamenco tango and salsa radio newspapers magazines libraries and blogs produced in spanish in japan by latin americans and spaniards who have lived in that country over the last three decades based on in depth research in archives throughout the country as well as field work including several interviews japanese speaking mexican scholar araceli tinajero uncovers a transnational contemporary cultural history that is not only important for today but for future generations

vale la pena vivirla pero no a cualquier precio frente a la voluntad de poder que predomina en la sociedad hay que oponerle como impugnación subversión y deseo una voluntad de vivir pedir a la vida que lo sea sin exigencias ni subordinaciones a sedicentes verdades políticas ideologías o imperativos religiosos para elucidar ese ciclo se recurre a lo fragmentario o mínima en vez del sistema o summa no es la vida al cabo un curso contingente que se explica mejor a través de sus fragmentos vida cuerpo palabra emociones sombra tránsitos memoria vacío crepúsculo y muerte componen con lenguaje preciso y sin concesiones a la banalidad los territorios y la cartografía del ciclo alberto hernando 1950 es licenciado en historia moderna y contemporánea formó parte de la redacción de cuadernos de ruedo ibérico ha colaborado como crítico literario y articulista sobre temas culturales en la vanguardia el mundo y el periódico de catalunya el europeo quimera el viejo topo y turia en la actualidad escribe asiduamente en las revistas lateral y letras libres

un viaje a las luces de neón tokiotas una historia indescrptible con la que tal vez vuelvas a creer en el amor una periodista con una gran ambición una investigación arriesgada un asesino con un objetivo y dos corazones a punto de romperse mia kobayashi siente que su carrera como periodista en el washington post hace aguas por eso cuando su jefe le ofrece la posibilidad de ir a tokió para esclarecer un asunto turbio que podría comprometer al candidato a la presidencia de estados unidos no lo duda una vez allí se da cuenta de que a pesar de tener raíces japonesas no va a ser fácil desenvolverse en una ciudad que es de todo menos simple la investigación la lleva hasta los bajos fondos un territorio controlado por la yakuza la mafia local que enseguida pone precio a su cabeza el samurái un asesino con fama de despiadado a las órdenes del clan más sanguinario de tokió será el encargado de darle caza lo que ninguno de los dos intuye es que las cosas no sucederán como estaba previsto gracias a un estilo ágil fresco y dinámico carmen sereno construye un enemies to lovers lleno de emotividad y acción el corazón del samurái nos traslada a las luces de neón de los suburbios tokiotas y nos envuelve en el misterio de unos personajes contradictorios que estarán dispuestos a todo con tal de dar respuesta a las inquietudes de su corazón una novela peligrosa y encantadora que hará las delicias de los amantes de japon amor pasión suspense corrupción venganza resiliencia y romanticismo se dan la mano en una historia única

at the intersection of translation studies and latin american literary studies the translator s visibility examines contemporary novels by a cohort of writers including prominent figures such as cristina rivera garza césar aira mario bellatin valeria luiselli and luis fernando verissimo who foreground translation in their narratives drawing on latin america s long tradition of critical and creative engagement of translation these novels explicitly visibly use major tropes of translation theory such as gendered and spatialized metaphors for the practice and the concept of untranslatability to challenge the strictures of intellectual property and propriety while shifting asymmetries of discursive authority above all between the original as a privileged repository of meaning and translation as its hollow emulation in this way the translator s visibility show that translation not only serves to renew national literatures through an exchange of ideas and forms when rendered visible it can help us reimagine the terms according to which those exchanges take place ultimately it is a book about language and power not only the ways in which power wields language but also the ways in which language can be used to unseat power
