his destination antarctica his expectations high veteran explorer sir ernest shackleton set out on the eve of the first world war in pursuit of his goal to lead the first expedition across the last unknown continent instead his ship the endurance became locked in sea ice and for nine months shackleton fought a losing battle with the elements before the drifting ship was crushed and his crew marooned shackleton's gripping account of his incredible voyage follows him and his men across 600 miles of unstable ice floes to a barren rock called elephant island it records how with a crew of four he crossed 850 miles of the worst seas in a twenty two foot long open boat and how after landing on south georgia island they then had to traverse over twenty miles of mountainous terrain to reach the nearest outpost of civilization shackleton recounts too the efforts of his support party aboard the aurora who in temperatures of 50 degree and winds of 80 mph still managed to drop off supplies on the opposite side of the continent little suspecting the fate of the endurance and the ordeal of its crew the harrowing experience recounted in shackleton's memoir is also strikingly illustrated with eighty eight diagrams and original photographs taken in the course of this incredible voyage
