her since he didn't know that she was also required to bring him food² in north korea marriage was a way for prisoners to escape their sentence and it was often used as a reward for good work for prisoners children however the experience was often marred by their parents interactions with guards who taught them that they were prisoners because of the sins of their parents³ when shin was ten he went to see his mother at the rice farm he watched as she had sex with a guard he never asked his mother about what he saw and never mentioned it to his father⁴ north korea's food problem is not limited to just the labor camps it has stunted the bodies of millions across the country the country needs to produce more than five million tons of rice and cereal grain to feed its twenty three million people but it rarely produces enough
