What are Idioms Phrasal Verbs and Collocations Before we get into specifics lets clarify the terms Idioms These are expressions where the meaning isnt literal Think of them as little puzzles where the whole is greater than the sum of its parts For example to kick the bucket means to die not literally to kick a bucket Phrasal Verbs These are verbs combined with prepositions or adverbs or both creating a meaning different from the verb alone Look up to search for information is a phrasal verb look by itself doesnt mean the same thing Collocations These are words that frequently appear together Theyre not always fixed expressions like idioms but they sound more natural when used together For example make a decision is a collocation do a decision sounds unnatural

Once in a blue moon Rarely We go out to dinner once in a blue moon
