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zambia is a nation with a long record of peace that has enjoyed decades of constitutional rule and even in recent years an increasingly competitive democracy peace constitutionalism democracy and nationhood face constant challenges such as in the elections of 2006 when the ugly language of ethnic confrontation found renewed currency moreover zambia s economic record and prospects are less equivocal after over four decades per capita incomes are lower than they were at the dawn of independence historical dictionary of zambia fourth edition contains a chronology an introduction and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has more than 1 000 cross referenced entries on important personalities as well as aspects of the country s politics economy foreign relations religion and culture this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about zambia

this report compiles recent evidence on the zambian health labor market and provides some baseline information on human resources for health hrh to help the government address its hrh challenges rather than focusing on making policy recommendations the report is designed to be a source book to benefit and fuel discussions related to hrh in zambia most of the data presented in the report covers the period 2005 08 the report analyzes the national health labor market to better understand the available evidence related to the stock distribution and performance of hrh in zambia that is the hrh outcomes it aims to explain those hrh outcomes by mapping assessing and analyzing pre service education and labor market dynamics that is the flow of health workers into within and out of the health labor market as well as the core factors influencing these dynamics finally this report examines the issue of access and equity of hrh it finds that even if health workers are available in either urban or rural areas and performing adequately the wealthy in zambia have better access to services than the poor this situation is found in most if not all other countries the report finds that as far as access to health workers is concerned the poor generally loose out it also reveals that even if health workers are available wealthier segments of the population often continue to have better access to health workers than poorer segments wealthier women have the highest probability of receiving any antenatal care there is an even steeper pro rich gradient in delivery attendance in zambia in contrast to antenatal care there is little variation across socioeconomic quintiles among those seeking medical treatment for children with diarrhea or cough and fever the poor are slightly more likely to be visited by a health worker and receive certain services during visits the factors linked to these variations in use of services remain to be examined they could be linked to expense fear of receiving care from an individual belonging to

a higher social stratum or different gender and so forth either way they should be taken into consideration when planning to improve access for the poor to health care services and providers

this book interrogates the ideology and practices of liberal constitutionalism in the zambian postcolony the analysis focuses on the residual political and governmental effects of an imperial form of power embodied in the person of the republican president termed here prerogativism through systematic long term ethnographic engagement with zambian constitutionalist activists lawyers judges and civic leaders the study examines how prerogativism has shaped the postcolonial political landscape and limited the possibilities of constitutional liberalism this is revealed in the ways that repeated efforts to reform the constitution have sidelined popular participation and thus failed to address the deep divide between a small elite stratum from which the constitutional activists are drawn and the marginalized masses of the population along the way the study documents the intimate interpenetration of political and legal action and examines how prerogativism delimits the political engagements of elite actors special attention is given to the reluctance of legal activists to engage with popular politics and to the conservative ethos that undermines efforts to pursue a jurisprudence of transformational constitutionalism in the findings of the constitutional court the work contributes to the rising interest in applying socio legal analysis to the statutory domain in postcolonial jurisdictions it offers a pioneering attempt to deconstruct the amorphous and ambivalent assemblage of ideas and practices related to constitutionalism through detailed ethnographic interrogation it will appeal to scholars students and practitioners with an interest in theorizing challenges to political liberalism in postcolonial contexts as well as in rethinking the methodological toolbox of socio legal analysis

this handbook offers a comprehensive and authoritative account of the zambian economy including past and current trends the zambian economy has evolved from simple and fragmented agrarian activities at the turn of the 20th century into a wide range of organized and regulated modern economic activities today while the economy has largely revolved around the mining industry since the early 1920s when the extraction of copper and other mineral ores on the copperbelt begun there has been a gradual broadening of economic activities over time with services now accounting for almost two thirds of gross domestic product gdp this book shows that since colonial times one of the persistent items on the economic development agenda in what is today known as zambia has been the need to diversify the economy to reduce dependence on mining in terms of foreign exchange earnings and public revenue while the need to diversify the economy has been well acknowledged by successive zambia governments including the current government achieving this goal has proved to be elusive so far by presenting a collection of well researched and empirically supported chapters on the key areas of the zambian economy this volume gives readers a good sense of where the zambian economy has come from where it is at the moment but also highlights the challenges and prospects for economic growth

based on in depth fieldwork in three cities dar es salaam zanzibar and lusaka this book provides a critical analysis of the united nations sustainable cities program in africa scp focusing on the scp s policies for solid waste management which was identified as the top priority problem by the scp the book examines the success of these pilot schemes and the scp s record in building new relationships between people and government it argues that the scp has operated in a political vacuum without recognition of the long and problematic histories and cultural politics of urban environmental governance in eastern and southern africa this book brings these cultural and political histories to the fore in its examination of the contemporary dynamics in doing so it not only provides an insightful analysis of the policies and outcomes for the scp but also puts forward a historically grounded critique of neoliberalism good governance and sustainable development discourses

over the past few decades the developing world has seen unprecedented urban growth and urban areas have had to deal with a number of complex problems as a result while population growth is one of the factors contributing to the deprivation and decay characteristic of most urban areas in the developing world there are other factors apart from demographic and economic factors the political organization factor of centralization has concentrated decision making and with it resources in the urban areas leading to further rural urban migration

another factor is one of colonialism the transfer of foreign social structures and technology while offering alternatives has dislocated and significantly altered indigenous patterns of development in the developing world this book examines a region where this last factor is a major significance zambia s copperbelt here the concentration of towns which were developed very rapidly in the 1930s made zambia one of the most highly urbanized sub saharan countries by focusing on copperbelt towns the book provides a critical analysis of the development of urban policy in zambia aspects of conflict and cooperation between different interest groups and where relevant their economic relationships are explored and a structural conflict model of urban management is proposed the book concludes that with proper management existing and emerging sectional interests in urban areas can help provide conditions which foster the formulation of equitable urban policy although focused on zambia the proposed structural conflict approach has potential for wider application
