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technology acquisition consultancy know how research data and services marketing information intellectual property the list of sources and types of knowledge that organizations need to acquire share and manage is growing exponentially the acquisition and management of knowledge as an end in itself is relatively new but has grown in importance on most managers agendas over the past fifteen years and is something that many managers are still fundamentally ill equipped to control effectively yet it is their ability to plan source evaluate acquire and manage knowledge on which the success of their organizations increasingly depends peter sammons provides managers with a readable highly practical guide to buying and managing knowledge the author looks at the knowledge economy to set the scene on the manager s growing responsibility to buy in knowledge for their organization he explores intellectual property rights how they are created transferred and protected he sets out some alternative strategies to buying knowledge there s advice on how to work with universities contract research organizations and consultancy firms and the most neglected area of all knowledge transfer from supplier to buyer is given exhaustive treatment in a discipline knowledge work that is fraught with jargon technology and arcane practice buying knowledge enables every manager to acquire the knowledge their organization needs in a form and at a cost that is most appropriate for them without exposing their organization to litigation or intellectual property disputes

this book explores the relationship between space and economy the spatial expressions of the knowledge economy the capitalist industrial economy produced its own space which differed radically from its predecessor agrarian and mercantile economies if a new knowledge based economy is emerging it is similarly expected to produce its own space to suit the new circumstances of production and consumption if these spatial expressions do exist even if in incomplete and partial forms they are likely to be the model for the

future of cities

this book describes methods and tools that empower information providers to build and maintain knowledge graphs including those for manual semi automatic and automatic construction implementation and validation and verification of semantic annotations and their integration into knowledge graphs it also presents lifecycle based approaches for semi automatic and automatic curation of these graphs such as approaches for assessment error correction and enrichment of knowledge graphs with other static and dynamic resources chapter 1 defines knowledge graphs focusing on the impact of various approaches rather than mathematical precision chapter 2 details how knowledge graphs are built implemented maintained and deployed chapter 3 then introduces relevant application layers that can be built on top of such knowledge graphs and explains how inference can be used to define views on such graphs making it a useful resource for open and service oriented dialog systems chapter 4 discusses applications of knowledge graph technologies for e tourism and use cases for other verticals lastly chapter 5 provides a summary and sketches directions for future work the additional appendix introduces an abstract syntax and semantics for domain specifications that are used to adapt schema org to specific domains and tasks to illustrate the practical use of the approaches presented the book discusses several pilots with a focus on conversational interfaces describing how to exploit knowledge graphs for e marketing and e commerce it is intended for advanced professionals and researchers requiring a brief introduction to knowledge graphs and their implementation
