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this book offers a collection of articles that together develop a systematic understanding of family some examine cross cultural and historical variations of family patterns in order to highlight the social organization of things that otherwise seem natural the bulk of articles focus on the social relations of sexuality and intimacy reproduction parenting and living together because these relations are typically gender relations a concern about gender inequality is constant throughout the book nearly three dozen scholars have contributed to this collection and while most of the articles were previously published several are new

family patterns gender relations is a reader featuring a mix of classic and contemporary readings from canada the us and the uk designed to introduce second and third year sociology students to the key issues in family studies today

is civil society's influence favorable to the evolvement of democratic structures and democratic gender relations while traditional approaches would answer in the affirmative the authors highlight the ambivalences focusing on women's organizations in authoritarian and hybrid regimes they cover the full spectrum of civil society's possible performance from its important role in the overcoming of power relations to its reinforcement as backers of government structures or the distribution of antifeminist ideas

how did wwi affect the love lives of ordinary citizens and their interactions as couples this book focuses on how dramatic changes in living conditions affected key parts of the life course of ordinary citizens marriage and divorce innovative in bringing together demographic and gender perspectives contributions in this comparative volume draw on newly available micro level data as well as qualitative sources such as war diaries in a first exploration intended to incite further research it asks how patterns of marriage and divorce were affected by the war across europe and what the role of enduring change or lack thereof in gender relations was in shaping these patterns

ancient china and greece are two classical civilisations that have exerted far reaching influence in numerous areas of human experience and are often invoked as the paradigms in east west comparison this book examines gender relations in the two ancient societies as reflected in convivial contexts such as family banquets public festivals and religious feasts two distinct patterns of interpersonal affinity and conflict emerge from the chinese and greek sources that show men and women organising themselves and interacting with each other in social occasions intended for collective pursuit of pleasure through an analysis of the two different patterns yiqun zhou illuminates the different socio political mechanisms value systems and fabrics of human bonds in the two classical traditions her book will be important for readers who are interested in the comparative study of societies gender studies women s history and the legacy of civilisations

african women theologians have written extensively about problems in gender relations in african contexts identifying oppressive elements and their effects on women s self concept and status in the church

family and society this book provides much needed pastoral theological attention and a response to the psychospiritual relational and sociocultural effects of gender injustice and marginalization of women it critically examines concepts methods and principles of family systems theory analyzes gender relations in african families and churches and develops a theology of pastoral care based on the trinitarian concept of perichoresis that offers pastoral guidelines for effective pastoral counseling with women and men as well as recommendations for corrective and preventative care grounded in educational strategies the paradigm of pastoral care that emerges attends both to women affected by gender injustice and to the sociocultural norms that cause distress and perpetuate gender oppression

this book provides the first resource dedicated to critically examining gender and sex in study designs methods and analysis in health research in order to produce ethical accurate and effective research findings it is vital to integrate both sex biological characteristics and gender socially constructed factors into any health study this book draws attention to some of the methodological complexities in this enterprise and offers ways to thoughtfully address these by drawing on empirical examples across a range of topics and disciplines

this title was first published in 2001 the development of gender relations during the post war period in sweden germany and the us forms the core of this work it looks at the hierarchical relations between men and women based on economic political social and biological differentiations the analytical focus is primarily on how actors cultural norms and institutional arrangements interrelate and affect the relative position of men and women to create patterns forms of gender relations that vary across countries and change through time the main advantages of a comparative study is that it highlights the differences and similarities of the countries being compared this book argues that social blocks involving a stable system of relations that have challenged and become embedded into institutional arrangements are the main force creating differences in the patterns of gender relations across the countries

sex gender and substance use describes how both biological and social factors affect people s use of substances there is a lot of research carried out on substance use prevention and treatment in which sex and gender are missing this book describes the concepts of sex and

gender what they mean and why including them in substance use research practice and policy is vital substances such as alcohol drugs nicotine and tobacco all have differential effects on females and males social and cultural gendered factors affect how women and men react to prevention treatment and policies the book includes numerous examples of how sex and gender sensitive research can increase our understanding and improve prevention and treatment and why striving for gender transformative substance use practice and research remains a gold standard

during the past three decades feminist scholars have successfully demonstrated the ubiquity and omnirelevance of gender as a sociocultural construction in virtually all human collectivities past and present intrapsychic interactional and collective social processes are gendered as are micro meso and macro social structures gender shapes and is shaped in all arenas of social life from the most mundane practices of everyday life to those of the most powerful corporate actors contemporary understandings of gender emanate from a large community of primarily feminist scholars that spans the gamut of learned disciplines and also includes non academic activist thinkers however while incorporating some cross disciplinary material this volume focuses specifically on sociological theories and research concerning gender which are discussed across the full array of social processes structures and institutions as editor i have explicitly tried to shape the contributions to this volume along several lines that reflect my long standing views about sociology in general and gender sociology in particular first i asked authors to include cross national and historical material as much as possible this request reflects my belief that understanding and evaluating the here and now and working realistically for a better future can only be accomplished from a comparative perspective too often american sociology has been both tempero and ethnocentric second i have asked authors to be sensitive to within gender differences along class racial ethnic sexual preference and age cohort lines

this book examines changing gender roles relations and hierarchies in an ethnic minority community in central viet nam after decades of war the community continued its self sufficient way of life in this remote forested mountainous region but in recent years has been forced to respond to severe climate threats combined with sudden and destabilizing socioeconomic and regulatory change through the use of both qualitative interview based and quantitative research methods the book offers insights into the complex interactions between

climate regulatory and socioeconomic changes including paradoxically the emergence of significant problems for both the community and the environment in the wake of policies designed to protect the natural environment facing greatly increased food and livelihood insecurity the women and men of the community were pushed into the mainstream market economy without being fully prepared to participate in an economy that is still very new to them these sudden transitions caused major shifts in gender roles and hierarchies opening up new possibilities for women to increase their social status in a highly patriarchal context but also at a cost for both women and men as women's burdens increased and men's traditional roles and livelihoods were lost the book examines recent trends including unanticipated changes and new possible policy related approaches and draws international comparisons with other ethnic minority indigenous and remote communities facing similar complex forces of change this book will be of interest to scholars and postgraduate students of climate change gender environment and public policy and development studies

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is sport good for kids when answering this question both critics and advocates of youth sports tend to fixate on matters of health whether condemning contact sports for their concussion risk or prescribing athletics as a cure for the childhood obesity epidemic child's play presents a more nuanced examination of the issue considering not only the physical impacts of youth athletics but its psychological and social ramifications as well the eleven original scholarly essays in this collection provide a probing look into how sports in community athletic leagues in schools and even on television play a major role in how young people view themselves shape their identities and imagine their place in society rather than focusing exclusively on self-proclaimed jocks the book considers how the culture of sports affects a wide variety of children and young people including those who opt out of athletics not only does child's play examine disparities across lines of race class and gender it also offers detailed examinations of how various minority populations from transgender youth to muslim immigrant girls have participated in youth sports taken together these essays offer a wide range of approaches to understanding the sociology of youth sports including data driven analyses that examine national trends as well as ethnographic research that gives a voice to individual kids child's play thus presents a comprehensive and compelling analysis of how for

better and for worse the culture of sports is integral to the development of young people and with them the future of our society

the answer of course is both in this lucid and subtle investigation sylvia walby one of the world's leading authorities on gender shows how undoubted increases in opportunity for women in europe and america have been accompanied by new forms of inequality she charts changes in women's employment education and political representation and the complex relations between gender class and ethnicity between local conditions and global pressures which together determine the place of women both in the labour market and in the wider social political and economic world of today an eagerly awaited successor to walby's classic theorising patriarchy transforming gender will be essential reading for anyone with an interest in how questions of gender remake and are remade by the social and economic conditions in which they occur

beere has produced a new edition of her women and women's issues a handbook of tests and measurements based largely on a search of the psychlit and eric databases from january 1978 to december 1988 the volume includes information on 211 tests and measures pertaining to gender roles and attitudes towards gender particularly useful are chapter reviews of the literature in which the author reviews the quality of available research recommended for college and university libraries choice this handbook stems in part from the author's previously published women and women's issues realizing that a book published in 1979 could no longer provide researchers with the up to date information they require regarding measures to use in research beere set out to revise and update her work in the process she soon discovered that the measures identified through her search of the literature produced since her first book was published far exceeds the number that can be realistically described in a single handbook thus she has undertaken a two volume guide the first of which gender roles describes only those measures pertaining to gender roles and attitudes toward gender related issues gender roles are broadly defined to include adults and children's gender roles gender stereotypes marital roles parental roles employee roles and multiple roles a total of 211 measures are included in addition to 67 scales still in use that were described in her earlier book beere includes scales that are relevant have evidence of their reliability and or validity and are used in more than one published article or eric document if a scale does not satisfy these criteria but its development is the focus of an article or eric document it is

included as are scales that are unusual or pertain to a topic that would otherwise receive inadequate coverage in this handbook the scale descriptions follow a standard format that includes the following information title author or authors as listed in the earliest publication mentioning the scale earliest date that the scale is mentioned in a publication profile of variable being measured type of instrument description sample items previous and appropriate subjects scoring information a description of the development of the measure information regarding reliability and validity and a listing of published studies that use the measure this important new handbook promises to make several important contributions to gender related research it will make it easier for researchers to locate quality instruments appropriate for their research discourage the proliferation of substandard or redundant measures set some minimal standards for measures used in gender role research and encourage more research regarding gender roles all social science libraries will want to find a place for it in their reference collections

the striking fact that abortion was among the first issues raised after 1989 by almost all of the newly formed governments of east central europe points to the significance of gender and reproduction in the postsocialist transformations the fourteen studies in this volume result from a comparative collaborative research project on the complex relationship between ideas and practices of gender and political economic change the book presents detailed evidence about women s and men s new circumstances in eight of the former communist countries exploring the intersection of politics and the life cycle the differential effects of economic restructuring and women s public and political participation individual contributions on the former german democratic republic poland the czech republic slovakia hungary serbia romania and bulgaria provide rich empirical data and interpretive insights on postsocialist transformation analyzed from a gendered perspective drawing on multiple methods and disciplines these original papers advance scholarship in several fields including anthropology sociology women s studies law comparative political science and regional studies the analyses make clear that practices of gender and ideas about the differences between men and women have been crucial in shaping the broad social changes that have followed the collapse of communism in addition to the editors the contributors are eleonora zieleńska eva maleck lewy myra marx ferree sharon wolchik irene dölling daphne hahn sylka scholz mira marody anna giza poleszczuk katalin kovács mónika váradi julia szalai adriana baban

since the year 2000 millions of hectares of land in the global south have been acquired by foreign investors for large scale agricultural projects displacing and disrupting rural communities women are especially disadvantaged by the global land grab they are less likely to inherit control or make decisions over land but often need land to support themselves their families and their communities while international organizations have developed global guidelines to improve land governance tensions still run high as the current policies fall short gender and the global land grab introduces a feminist conceptual framework to analyze land governance policy around the world andrea collins shows how gender norms biases and expectations shape land politics at different levels of governance drawing on examples from sub saharan africa and with an in depth case study of land politics in tanzania the book assesses guidelines developed by institutions such as the food and agriculture organization of the united nations and the world bank to highlight essential considerations for developing and implementing gender sensitive policy illustrating how gender shapes resource policy across all levels of political activity gender and the global land grab provides valuable tools for transforming global policymaking

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
