this is a book about god specifically about the different ways jews have spoken of god throughout history in its examination of 4 000 years of jewish thought it presents the broad spectrum of theological opinions that have been explored and affirmed by great jewish thinkers ancient and modern many jews today avoid speaking about god unable to accept the traditional notions presented to them as authoritative they often turn to other faiths or cults that offer the possibility of spiritual expression more in keeping with their personal god concept unaware of the variety within judaism they abandon their religious community in the mistaken impression that their longing for god cannot be satisfied within the faith of their ancestors in this book the authors skillfully present ten distinct jewish theological perspectives each of which has something to say to us today about our lives as individuals and as jews each grapples with the following crucial questions what is god is there more than one god what is god s name how can we know god what is god s relationship to the world does god have a special relationship with the jewish people what does god want from us how does god relate to me why is there evil in the world if we make it possible for one jew to reclaim his or her jewish spiritual identity the authors write if we help others to begin to talk about god without ambivalence or embarrassment if we serve as a catalyst for further study of these and other jewish thinkers we will consider our work worthwhile

antisemitism in the german military community and the jewish response 1914 1938 explores how german world war i veterans from different social and political backgrounds contributed to antisemitic politics during the weimar republic the book compares how the military right wing veterans and jewish veterans chose to remember their war experiences and translate these memories into a political reality in the postwar world antisemitism addresses several neglected issues first there is relatively little scholarship discussing antisemitism in the imperial german army and the impact former imperial officers had on the antisemitic predilections of veteran associations this subject deserves attention given that veteran politics during the weimar republic were of tremendous significance to the collapse of democracy and the rise of national socialism and that the primary architects of the third reich and the final solution were either world war i veterans or had been members of paramilitary

organizations in the interwar period the second issue addressed is how veterans influenced the definition of aryan identity or how race came to be perceived through the prism of war and political violence since german jews had to fight both accusations of shirking military service and the perception of the jew as effeminate the manner in which these veterans tried to reforge jewish identity and their relationship with their former comrades is an extraordinarily important issue the third issue concerns situational antisemitism or the process by which an organization expressed an opinion or policy concerning jews in response to internal dissension and external influences

this in turn will be shown to be characteristic of the wider relationship between interwar european fascism and antisemitism a thus far relatively neglected issue in the burgeoning field of fascist studies tilles also argues that the buf s leader sir oswald mosley far from being a reluctant convert to the anti jewish cause or simply a cynical exploiter of it as much of the existing scholarship suggests was aware of the role antisemitism would play in his fascist doctrine from the start and remained in control of its subsequent development these findings are used to support the notion that contrary to prevailing perceptions jewish opposition to the buf played no part in provoking the fascists adoption of antisemitism britain s jews did nevertheless play a significant role in shaping british fascism s path of development and the wide ranging and effective anti fascist activity they pursued represents an important alternative narrative to the dominant image of jews as mere victims of fascism
