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opera has been performed in australia for more than two hundred years yet none of the operas written before the second world war have become part of the repertoire it is only in the late 1970s and early 1980s that there is evidence of the successful systematic production of indigenous opera the premiere of voss by richard meale and david malouf in 1986 was a watershed in the staging and reception of new opera and there has been a diverse series of new works staged in the last thirty years not only by the national company but also by thriving regional institutions the emergence of a thriving operatic tradition in contemporary australia is inextricably enmeshed in australian cultural consciousness and issues of national identity in this study of eighteen representative contemporary operas michael halliwell elucidates the ways in which the operas reflect and engage with the issues facing contemporary australians stylistically these eighteen operas vary greatly the musical idiom is diverse ranging from works in a modernist idiom such as the ghost wife whitsunday fly away peter black river and bride of fortune to voss batavia bliss lindy midnight son the riders the summer of the seventeenth doll and the children s bach being works which straddle several musical styles a number of operas draw strongly on musical theatre including the eighth wonder pecan summer the rabbits and cloudstreet and love in the age of therapy is couched in a predominantly jazz idiom while some of them are overtly political all at least tangentially deal with recent cultural politics in australia and offer sharply differing perspectives

issues of identity are central to many historical and current debates in australia this superb collection of essays represents a significant rethinking of received ideas on identity and reveals how issues of identity lie at the heart of australian political thought and form the foundation of australian society and culture it provides a comprehensive introduction to the political discourse surrounding australian identity through key themes including identity theory the manipulation of identity for political ends gender and sexuality immigration and national identity citizenship and aboriginality and literature and film the book rejects many of the assumptions underlying contemporary political debates including the promulgation of a singular national identity in historical fact or as a political goal this is a thought provoking study of identity its links with nationalism and its potentially divisive effects

beyond the obvious and enduring socio economic ravages it unleashed on indigenous cultures white settler colonization in
australasia also inflicted profound damage on the collective psyche of both of the communities that inhabited the contested
space of the colonial world the acute sense of alienation that colonization initially provoked in the colonized and colonizing
populations of australia and new zealand has recent studies indicate developed into an endemic existential pathology evidence
of the psychological fallout from the trauma of geographical deracination cultural disorientation and ontological destabilization
can be found not only in the state of anomie and self destructive patterns of behaviour that now characterize the lives of
indigenous australian and maori peoples but also in the perpetually faltering identity discourse and cultural rootlessness of the
present descendants of the countries anglo celtic settlers it is with the literary expression of this persistent condition of
alienation that the essays gathered in the present volume are concerned covering a heterogeneous selection of contemporary
australasian literature what these critical studies convincingly demonstrate is that more than two hundred years after the
process of colonisation was set in motion the experience that germaine greer has dubbed the pain of unbelonging continues
unabated constituting a dominant thematic concern in the writing produced today by australian and new zealand authors

at the beginning of the twenty first century it is necessary to combine into a productive programme the striving for individual emancipation and the social practice of humanism in order to help the world survive both the ancient pitfalls of particularist terrorism and the levelling tendencies of cultural indifference engendered by the renewed imperialist arrogance of hegemonial global capital in this book thirty five scholars address and negotiate in a spirit of learning and understanding an exemplary variety of intercultural splits and fissures that have opened up in the english speaking world their methodology can be seen to constitute a seminal field of intellectual signposts they point out ways and means of responsibly assessing colonial predicaments and postcolonial developments in six regions shaped in the past by the british empire and still associated today through their allegiance to the idea of a commonwealth of nations they show how a new ethic of literary self assertion interpretative mediation and critical responsiveness can remove the deeply ingrained prejudices silences and taboos established by discrimination against race class and gender

this edited collection aims to respond to dominant perspectives on twenty first century war by exploring how the events of 9 11 and the subsequent wars on terror are represented and remembered outside of the us framework existing critical coverage ignores the meaning of these events for people nations and cultures apparently peripheral to them but which have as shown in this collection been extraordinarily affected by the social political and cultural changes these wars have wrought adopting a literary and cultural history approach the book asks how these events resonate and continue to show effects in the rest of the world with a particular focus on australia and britain it argues that such reflections on the impact of the wars on terror help us to understand what global conflict means in a contemporary context as well as what its representative motifs might tell us about how nations like australia and britain perceive and construct their remembered identities on the world stage in the twenty first century in its close examination of films novels memoir visual artworks media and minority communities in the years since 2001 this collection looks at the global impacts of these events and the ways they have shaped and continue to shape britain and australia s relation to the rest of the world
