koistinen describes how an undeveloped preindustrial economy forced americans to fight defensive wars of attrition like the revolution and the war of 1812 by the time of the mexican war however a gradually maturing economy allowed the united states to use a much more offensive minded strategy to achieve its goals the book concludes with an exhaustive examination of the civil war a conflict that both anticipated and differed from the total wars of the industrialized era koistinen demonstrates that the north relied upon its enormous economic might to overwhelm the confederacy through a strategy of annihilation while the south bungled its own strategy of attrition by failing to mobilize effectively a much less developed economy

in this volume koistinen examines war planning and mobilizing in an era of rapid industrialization and reveals how economic mobilization for defense and war is shaped at the national level by the interaction of political economic and military institutions and by increasingly powerful and expensive weaponry

the period covered in this volume was one during which an initially small poorly funded and often unpopular military

continued its traditional subordination to civilian authority despite the dissatisfaction of many of its leaders even after the military achieved victory over spain and began to rule overseas colonial possessions giving it new prestige and influence the experience of the previous decades ensured that the traditional principle of civilian control remained strong significant tensions developed between civilian and military leaders as the military was sent on missions in the reconstruction south and the indian west into overseas wars against the spanish and filipino nationalists and on interventions in the caribbean and central america
