petra schönemann behrens provides an informative review of the life and times of alfred h fried 1864 1921 a significant if underappreciated german pacifist of the late nineteenth century and early twentieth century in response to the militarism and international anarchy of the european states fried developed his unique notion of revolutionary or scientific pacifism differentiating it from reform pacifism in order to address the material causes of war as theorist practitioner and journalist fried advanced radical ideas at the time the formation of a pan european union the establishment of an effective international court of arbitration the elimination of a secretive diplomatic class and the expansion of international economic and cultural cooperation this book is a translation of the german biography alfred h fried friedensaktivist nobelpreisträger published by römerhof verlag in 2011 and commemorates the 100th anniversary of fried s death

this analysis of the historical evolution and contemporary form of the system of world politics utilizes contemporary theories and debates in sociology and global history critically reflecting also on world politics in the field of international relations this book will appeal to a wide readership in a range of fields

a comprehensive intellectual history of the idea of the west how did the west come to be used as a collective self designation signaling political and cultural commonality when did westerners begin to refer to themselves in this way was the idea handed down from the ancient greeks or coined by nineteenth century imperialists neither writes georgios varouxakis in the west his ambitious and fascinating genealogy of the idea the west was not used by plato cicero locke mill or other canonized figures of what we today call the western tradition it was not first wielded by empire builders it gradually emerged as of the 1820s and was then varouxakis shows decisively promoted in the 1840s by the french philosopher auguste comte whose political project incidentally was passionately anti imperialist the need for the use of the term the west emerged to avoid the confusing or unwanted consequences of the use of europe the two overlapped but were not identical with the west used to differentiate from certain others within europe as well as to include

the americas after examining the origins varouxakis traces the many and often astonishingly surprising changes in the ways in which the west has been understood and the different intentions and consequences related to a series of these contested definitions while other theories of the west consider only particular aspects of the concept and its history if only in order to take aim at its reputation varouxakis s analysis offers a comprehensive account that reaches to the present day exploring the multiplicity of current and not least prospective future meanings he concludes with an examination of how since 2022 definitions and membership of the west have been reworked to consider ukraine as the evolution and redefinitions continue

in the heroic earth david t murphy argues that geopolitical ideas were most dynamic and significant in germany not during the nazi era 1933 45 but in the democratic culture of the weimar republic 1919 33 by helping to condition the german population to geopolitical ideas which emphasized revision of the versailles settlement and enlarging germany s living space geopolitics helped contribute to nazi imperialism from the defeat of germany in 1918 until the rise of national socialism in 1933 theories of geographical determinism enjoyed a broad currency in many fields of german public life the ancient notion that environmental factors climate topography resource distribution shape society in significant ways was now applied in a radically determinist fashion to help germans understand why they had lost the war and what they had to do to regain their place among the great powers under the rubric of geopolitik politicians teachers writers and others argued that they key to germany s past and the hope for its future lay in understanding geography s determining impact upon races cultures states and warfare theories of geographical determinism shaped german thinking about politics race science education aesthetics and many other subjects on the eve of the nazi era challenging traditional historiography murphy argues that geopolitics faded in importance after adolf hitler came to power

the west is a central idea in german public discourse yet historians know surprisingly little about the evolution of the concept contrary to common assumptions this volume argues that the german concept of the west was not born in the twentieth century but can be traced from a much earlier time in the nineteenth century the west became associated with notions of progress liberty civilization and modernity it signified the future through the opposition to antonyms such as russia and the east and was deployed as a tool for forging german identities examining the shifting meanings political uses and transnational circulations of the idea of the west sheds new light on german intellectual history from the post napoleonic era to the cold war

Restauration der politischen Verhältnisse Europas zur gleichen Zeit stand auch fest, dass die fortgesetzte koloniale Rivalität des 18. Jahrhunderts zwischen Frankreich und Großbritannien das Jahrzehntelange Ringen beider Mächte um den Status der dominierenden Weltmacht endgültig zu Gunsten Großbritanniens entschieden worden war. Es war das zweite britische Empire, das sich nach 1815 als führende Weltmacht etablierte und dies war im Wesentlichen das Ergebnis zweier Kriege: des siebenjährigen Krieges und der napoleonischen Kriege. In der vorliegenden Arbeit sollen diese beiden Kriege nun aus Globalisierungshistorischer Perspektive betrachtet werden. Handelt es sich doch um die ersten wirklich globalen Auseinandersetzungen der Geschichte, da besonders der britisch-französische Konflikt nicht allein in Europa, sondern weltweit ausgetragen wurde. Dabei soll der Frage nachgegangen werden, wo sich innerhalb dieser Kriege Globalisierungselemente bzw. Defizite finden lassen. Dazu wird im ersten Kapitel zunächst auf allgemeine Fragen zur Globalisierung als einem auch historischen Phänomen eingegangen. Im zweiten Kapitel folgt dann eine knappe Darstellung zu beiden Kriegen, wobei die globale Dimension dieser Auseinandersetzungen schon erkennbar werden soll. Im dritten Teil sollen schließlich explizit Globalisierungselemente sowie die globalen Dimensionen der Kriegsziele und Strategien beider Seiten verdeutlicht und daneben auch ein Beispiel von Fragmentierung innerhalb dieser globalen Konflikte gezeigt werden. Seine aktuelle Bedeutung gewinnt das Thema einer Geschichte der Globalisierung aus der Tatsache, dass Globalisierung heute für uns allgegenwärtig ist und einen bestimmenden Einfluss auf unser Leben besitzt. Dabei ist Globalisierung ein Phänomen mit langer Vorgeschichte, und die Beschäftigung mit dieser Geschichte erscheint heute geradezu notwendig, um aktuelle Ereignisse einordnen und besser verstehen zu können. So lassen sich etwa übermäßige Euphorie oder Ängste vermeiden, wenn das Bewusstsein vorhanden ist, dass Globalisierung heute kein neues, unbekanntes Phänomen, sondern eine gewisse Kontinuität in der Geschichte darstellt.

The disintegration of the Cold War division of Europe and the reunification of Germany have given new significance to the debate about the political, economic, and cultural structure at the heart of Europe. *Mitteleuropa: History and Prospects* examines this topic in the light of recent research and analyzes the conflicting attempts to understand and shape the region over the last century. The contributors give detailed critical and historical assessments of the role of Germany, the social, political, and economic distinctiveness of the region, and the attitude of the states outside the area. Finally, they discuss future prospects for Europe.

Cataclysms is a profoundly original look at the last century approaching twentieth-century history from the periphery rather than the centers of decision making. The virtual narrator sits perched on the legendary stairs of Odessa and watches as events between the Baltic and the Aegean pass in review, unfolding in space and time between 1917 and 1989 while evoking the nineteenth century as an interpretative backdrop. Influenced by continental historical, legal, and social thought, Dan Diner views the totality of world history evolving from an eastern and southeastern European angle. A work of great synthesis, *Cataclysms* chronicles twentieth-century history as a universal civil war between a succession of conflicting dualisms such as freedom and equality, race and class, capitalism and communism, liberalism and fascism. East and West, Diner's interpretation rotates around cataclysmic events in the transformation from multinational empires into nation-states, accompanied by social revolution and ethnic cleansing, situating the Holocaust at the core of the century's predicament. Unlike other Eurocentric interpretations of the last century, Diner also highlights the emerging pivotal importance of the United States and the impact of decolonization on the process of European integration.

The subject of volume II of the *General History of the Caribbean* is the evolution of
