this book brings together geological biological radical economic technological historical and social perspectives on peak oil and other scarce resources the contributors to this volume argue that these scarcities will put an end to the capitalist system as we know it and alternatives must be created the book combines natural science

with emancipatory thinking focusing on bottom up alternatives and social struggles to change the world by taking action the volume introduces original contributions to the debates on peak oil land grabbing and social alternatives thus creating a synthesis to gain an overview of the multiple crises of our times the book sets out to analyse how crises of energy climate metals minerals and the soil relate to the global land grab which has accelerated greatly since 2008 as well as to examine the crisis of profit production and political legitimacy based on a theoretical understanding of the multiple crises and the effects of peak oil and other scarcities on capital accumulation the contributors explore the social innovations that provide an alternative using the most up to date research on resource crises this integrative and critical analysis brings together the issues with a radical perspective on possibilities for future change as well as a strong social economic and ethical dimension the book should be of interest to researchers and students of environmental policy politics sustainable development and natural resource management

water is a global resource for modern societies and water was a global resource for pre modern societies the many different water systems serving processes of urbanisation and urban life in ancient times and the middle ages have hardly been researched until now the numerous contributions to this volume pose questions such as what the basic cultural significance of water was the power of water in the town and for the town from different points of view symbolic aesthetic and cult aspects are taken up as is the role of water in politics society and economy in daily life but also in processes of urban planning or in urban neighbourhoods not least the dangers of polluted water or of flooding presented a challenge to urban society the contributions in this volume draw attention to the complex manifold relations between water and human beings this collection presents the results of an international conference in kiel in 2018 it is directed towards both scholars in ancient and mediaeval studies and all those interested in the diversity of water systems in urban space in ancient and mediaeval times

the turn of the millennium has stimulated much scholarly reflection on the historical significance of the twentieth century as a whole explaining the century's dual legacy of progress and prosperity on one hand and of world war genocide and mass destruction on the other has become a key task for academics and policymakers alike not surprisingly germany holds a prominent position in the discussion what does it mean for a society to be so closely identified with both inflicting and withstanding enormous suffering as well as with promoting and enjoying unprecedented affluence what did germany's experiences of misery and abundance

the decade that gave rise to the term the hungry forties in europe is often regarded and rightly so as one of deprivation unrest and revolution two events the great irish famine and the various political events of 1848 stand out this book is the first to discuss the subsistence crisis of the 1840s in a truly comparative way this subsistence crisis may be divided into two rather distinct elements on the one hand the failure of the potato caused by the new unfamiliar fungus phytophthora infestans which first struck europe in mid 1845 resulted in a catastrophe in ireland that killed about one million people and radically transformed its landscape and economy poor potato crops in 1845 and in the following years also resulted in significant excess mortality elsewhere in europe on the other hand this period and 1846 in particular was also one of poor wheat and rye harvests throughout much of europe failure of the grain harvest alone rarely resulted in a subsistence crisis but the combination of poor potato and grain harvests in a single place was a lethal one connections between the local and the global between the economic and the political and between the rural and the industrial make the crisis of the late 1840s a multi layered one this book offers a comparative perspective on the causes and the effects of what is sometimes considered as the last european subsistence crisis it begins with an extensive introduction that treats the topic in comparative perspective the subsistence crisis had its most catastrophic impact in ireland and three chapters in the current volume are concerned mainly with that country a fourth chapter uses price data to shed comparative perspective on the crisis while the remaining nine chapters are case studies covering countries ranging from sweden to spain and from scotland to prussia throughout the contributors focus on a range of common themes such as the extent of harvest deficits the functioning of food markets fertility and mortality and public action at local and national levels cormac o grada is professor of economics at university college dublin he has worked extensively on the history of famines in ireland and worldwide richard paping teaches economic and social history and economics at university of groningen he has done extensive research on developments in standard of living economy and demography in the netherlands eric vanhaute is professor social and economic history and world history at ghent university he has mainly published on the history of the rural society and of labour markets in flanders and outside table of contents eric vanhaute richard paping and cormac o grada the european subsistence crisis of 1845 1850 a comparative perspective part i the irish famine in an international perspective cormac o grada ireland s great famine an overview mary e daly something old and something new recent research on the great irish famine peter m solar the crisis of the late 1840s what can be learned from prices peter gray the european food crisis and the
