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bertrand russell 1872 1970 was a logician a philosopher and one of the twentieth century s most visible public intellectuals science and apocalypse in bertrand russell a cultural sociology brings those three aspects together to trace russell s changing views on the role of science and technology in society throughout his long intellectual career drawing from cultural sociology history of science and philosophy javier pérez jara and lino camprubí provide a fresh multidimensional analysis of the general themes of science technology utopia and apocalypse the book critically examines russell s influential interpretations of the turn of the century mathematical logic world war i the metaphysics and epistemology of mind and matter world war ii nuclear holocaust and the vietnam war in russell s compelling narratives humanity was a powder keg and the match was represented by different and successive meta adversaries such as religion communism and american imperialism and the only way to avoid a coming global holocaust was to follow his own salvific recipes in working around russell s role in the cultural perception of the final destiny of humanity science and apocalypse in bertrand russell invites the reader to think about the place of the techno scientific sphere in human progress and decadence in both our current epoch and the distant future

this volume collects together russell s philosophical writings during the period from 1947 68 for about half of this period russell worked steadily at philosophy but after the publication of my philosophical development in 1959 he retired from academic philosophy for the second time after that date only the occasional philosophical piece appeared as he was preoccupied with political writings in this volume there are a handful of papers dated later than 1959 and all of these were certainly written by russell himself this volume contains russell s writings on diverse philosophical interests including autobiographical and self critical papers critiques of other philosophers and his controversial opinions on christianity

bertrand russell s professional philosophical reputation rests mainly on his mathematical logic and theory of knowledge in this study first published in 1985 however kenneth blackwell considers russell s writings on ethics and metaethics and uncovers the conceptual unity in russell s normative ethic he traces that unity to the influence of

spinoza's central ethical concept the intellectual love of god and then evaluates the ethic which he terms impersonal self enlargement the introduction discusses the metaethical background to russell's ethic and the difficulties inherent in russell's view that ethical knowledge is not possible the first section then examines russell's writings on spinoza from 1894 to 1964 dividing them into three periods the second part analyzes russell's two interpretations of the main concept traces impersonal self enlargement in russell's own ethical writings and evaluates the ethic in relation to other ethical theories and on its own merits as a way of living this book provides a foundation for a positive re evaluation of russell's status in the major philosophical field of ethics and will be welcomed by students of moral philosophy as well as those interested in bertrand russell's works

mysterious fear of defeat fear of death fear is the parent of cruelty and therefore it is no wonder if cruelty and religion have gone hand in hand it is in this vein that russell approached religion the essays in this book are representative of the full range of his thinking on the subject some of the essays included are my religious reminiscences a debate on the existence of god what is an agnostic and are the world s troubles due to decay in faith bertrand russell was the recipient of countless awards for excellence during his long lifetime 1872 1970 including the nobel prize for literature which he won in 1950 the range of his critical inquiry is without parallel in contemporary western culture

this is a brief introduction to ethics with a point of view the book addresses meta ethical questions that go beyond what most introductory ethics books address which are normative theories egoism utilitarianism etc and applied ethics abortion capital punishment etc

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
