research starts with sound literature review the purpose of a literature review is to provide a foundation of knowledge on the topic identify areas of prior scholarship to prevent duplication and give credit to other researchers identify inconstancies gaps in research conflicts in previous studies open questions left from other research most of the researchers face difficulty in a review of past studies
