implications still reverberating today the story is haunted by questions about whether taiwan is a
part of china or its own country what the costs are of standing up for one s beliefs and by the

choices made by one father and his daughter green island is a tough unsentimental and moving novel that is a memorial not only to the heroes but also to the survivors viet thanh nguyen pulitzer prize winning author of the sympathizer a stunning story of love betrayal and family set against the backdrop of a changing taiwan over the course of the twentieth century february 28 1947 trapped inside the family home amid an uprising that has rocked taipei dr tsai delivers his youngest daughter the unnamed narrator of green island just after midnight as the city is plunged into martial law in the following weeks as the chinese nationalists act to crush the opposition dr tsai becomes one of the many thousands of people dragged away from their families and thrown into prison his return after more than a decade is marked by alienation from his loved ones and paranoia among his community conflicts that loom over the growing bond he forms with his youngest daughter years later this troubled past follows her to the united states where as a mother and a wife she too is forced to decide between what is right and what might save her family the same choice she witnessed her father make many years before as the novel sweeps across six decades and two continents the life of the narrator shadows the course of taiwan s history from the end of japanese colonial rule to the decades under martial law and finally to taiwan s transformation into a democracy but above all green island is a lush and lyrical story of a family and a nation grappling with the nuances of complicity and survival raising the question how far would you be willing to go for the ones you love

multilingual although it can be analyzed through frameworks of japanophone literature and chinese literature and the more provocative sinophone literature only through viewing taiwanese literature as world literature can we redress the limits of national identity and fully examine writers transculturation practice globally minded vision and the politics of its circulation throughout the colonial era taiwanese writers gained inspiration from global literary trends mainly but not exclusively through the medium of japanese and chinese modernism was the mainstream literary style in 1960s taiwan and since the 1980s taiwanese literature has demonstrated a unique trajectory shaped jointly by postmodernism and postcolonialism these movements exhibit taiwanese writers creative adaptations of world literary thought as a response to their local and trans national reality during the postwar years taiwanese literature began to be more systematically introduced to world readers through translation over the past few decades taiwanese authors and their translated works have participated in global conversations such as those on climate change the post truth era and ethnic and gender equality bringing together scholars and translators from europe north america and east asia the volume focuses on three interrelated themes the framing and worlding ploys of taiwanese literature taiwanese writers experience of transculturation and politics behind translating taiwanese literature the volume stimulates new ways of conceptualizing taiwanese literature demonstrates remarkable cases of taiwanese authors co option of world trends in their taiwan concerned writing and explores its readership and dissemination

this book examines the impact of martial law on transgenerational memory in post world war ii taiwan through an intense focus on the symptoms of memories yu argues that collective remembrances in post war taiwan must be studied alongside the islanders collective amnesia as the post war regime coerced its citizens into forgetting to do so the book examines the core issue through the lens of two fictional works green island 2016 by shawna yang ryan and the stolen bicycle originally published in 2015 translated in 2017 by ming yi wu whose narrators belong to the post war generation and find themselves unable to understand their parents traumas it also observes how the war generation memorize consecutive and entangled colonial experiences experiencing linguistic and social diaspora without the act of migration ultimately yu argues that post memory in these circumstances not only refers to secondary memory but bears an anti memory characteristic as taiwanese society under martial law shunned the traumas of wwii and the march massacre in 1947

with a focus on the liminality of justice in trauma this collective volume probes into the complex liminal status of victim forced victimizer in trauma a new opening well deserving critical attention and scrutinizes how novelists tackle with literary representations the relevant issues of in justice in trauma the contributions in this collection present theoretical re visions of trauma and critical studies on trauma literature ranging from field work on cambodia s genocide to literary analyses of aids literature contemporary american literature contemporary canadian literature and indigenous writing in canada
