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world missions needs a fully biblical ethos this is the contention of the editors of and contributors to world mission a series of essays aimed at reforming popular approaches to missions in the first set of essays contributors develop a biblical theology of world missions from both the old and new testaments arguing that the theology of each must stand in the foreground of missions not recede into the background in the second they unfold the great commission in sequence detailing how it

determines the biblical strategy of all mission enterprises finally they treat current issues in world missions from the perspective of the sufficiency of scripture altogether this book aims to reform missions to be thoroughlyâ not just foundationallyâ biblical a needed correction even among the sincerest missionaries

this new volume in the award winning encountering mission series is for current and future missionaries it provides practical guidance regarding getting ready for the mission field and the realities of life on the field the authors are well qualified to write such a manual each having served as a missionary for more than twenty years and each having taught missions in seminary the authors begin by examining the contemporary context for missions including the recognition that the world's mission fields are in constant and often rapid change they then discuss aspects of preparing oneself for the mission field beginning with home front preparations and moving to on the field preparations the final section deals with practical issues and challenges of missionary life

understanding language contact offers an accessible and empirically grounded introduction to contact linguistics rather than taking a traditional focus on the outcomes of language contact this book takes the novel approach of considering these outcomes as an endpoint of bilingualism and multilingualism covering speech production and comprehension language diffusion across different interactional networks and timeframes and the historical outcomes of contact induced language change this book discusses both how these areas relate to one another and how they correspond to different theoretical fields and methodologies draws together concepts and methodological theoretical advances from the related fields of bilingualism and sociolinguistics to show how these can shed new light on the traditional field of contact linguistics presents up to date research in a digestible form includes examples from a wide range of contact languages including creoles and pidgins indigenous minority and heritage languages mixed languages and immigrants linguistic practices to illustrate ideas and concepts features exercises to test students understanding as well as suggestions for further reading to expand knowledge in specific areas written by three experienced teachers and researchers in this area understanding language contact is key reading for advanced undergraduate and postgraduate students approaching bilingualism and language contact for the first time

career defining crises in mission is written to help missionaries evaluate their ministry approaches and to pursue those that place relationships over programs each of the 12 chapters takes a well known missiological principle and instead of focusing on the theory behind it uses bible studies illustrations true stories and practical suggestions to encourage missionaries to make decisions that cultivate relationships with people as they choose mission methods

fictional languages in science fiction literature surveys a large number of fictional languages those created as part of a literary world to present a multifaceted account of the literary phenomenon of glossopoesis language invention consisting of a few untranslated sentences exotic names or even fully fledged languages with detailed grammar and vocabulary fictional languages have been a common element of english language fiction since thomas more s utopia 1516 different notions of the functions of such fictional languages in narrative have been proposed as rooted in phonaesthetics and contextual features or as being used for characterisation and construction of alterity framed within stylistics and informed by narrative theory literary theory literary pragmatics and semiotics this study combines previous typologies into a new 5 part reading model comprising unique analytical approaches tailored to science fiction s specific discourse and style exploring the relationship between glossopoesis world building storytelling interpretation and rhetoric both in prose and paratexts

experts in various branches of social science address the reader explaining the scope and limitations of their discipline in the science of missiology find the balance between those who discount the value of the sciences for missions and those who use them without discernment

an in situ or on location approach to language learning is presented for people going abroad for an extended period of time the approach features two components 1 the use of a mentor native speaker who lives in the community and serves as a guide and 2 the daily learning cycle of planning practicing communicating face to face and evaluating this approach gives the traveler responsibility for learning in real interaction situations with immediate feedback examples of topics covered include benchmarks for evaluation selection communication with and compensation for a mentor hints for increasing interaction opportunities language structures nuance and word clusters cultural appropriateness and getting a head start at home six detailed lesson plans are included for dining out transportation shopping currency medical needs and figuring out meanings of unfamiliar words contains 49 references lb

this book is about the theory and practice of assistance to speech communities whose native languages are threatened because their intergenerational continuity is proceeding negatively with fewer and fewer speakers or readers writers and even understanders every generation

this book looks into the accentual history of the japanese and the ryukyuan languages applying the comparative method the author has reconstructed the accentual history of the japonic languages the reconstruction is based on modern dialects of japanese and ryukyuan and also on historical materials the investigation of natural accent changes has allowed the author to formalize rules for accent change using these rules the developments of the accent systems of descendant dialects or languages are explained the development of typologically different accent systems is also explored

james blish in his incarnation as william atheling jr has written more than his share of the most incisive criticism of contemporary science fiction following on from the issue at hand this new volume of atheling s critical writings skewers literary malefactors of many kinds including some well known authors whose great popularity is all the more puzzling because there seems to be so little reason for it atheling does not stint on praise where it is due but in other cases the sins and errors of the filed are dispatched with his trademark rapier like incisiveness

this book collects a selection of fifteen papers presented at three meetings of the society for pidgin and creole linguistics in 1996 and 1997 the focus is on papers which approach issues in creole studies with novel perspectives address understudied

pidgin and creole varieties or compellingly argue for controversial positions the papers demonstrate how pidgins and creoles shed light on issues such as verb movement contact induced language change and its gradations discourse management via tense aspect particles language genesis substratal transfer and universal grammar and cover a wide range of contact languages ranging from english and french based creoles through portuguese creoles of africa and asia sango popular brazilian portuguese west african pidgin englishes and hawaiian creole english
