this is the last of three volumes of collected shorter prose to be published in the faber edition of the works of samuel beckett which already includes a volume of early stories the expelled the calmative the end first love and of late stories company ill seen ill said worstward ho stirrings still the present volume contains all of the short fictions some of them no longer than a page written and published by beckett between 1950 and the early 1970s most were written in french and they mostly belong within three loose sequences texts for nothing fizzles and residua the edition also includes two remarkable independent narratives from an abandoned work and as the story was told all of these texts whose unsleeping subject is themselves demonstrate that the short story is one of the recurrent modes of beckett s imagination and occasions some of his greatest works he would like it to be my fault that words fail him of course words fail him he tells his story every five minuts saying it is not his there s cleverness for you he would like ti to be my fault that he has no story of course he has no story that s no reason for trying to foist one on me

the gongsun longzi is often considered the only extant work of the classical chinese school of names an early intellectual tradition trad dated to the 4th cent b c mainly concerned with logic and the philosophy of language the gongsun longzi is a heterogeneous collection of five chapters that include short treatises and largely fictive dialogues between an anonymous persuader and his opponent which typically revolve around a paradoxical claim its value as a testimony to early chinese philosophy however is somewhat controversial due to the intricate textual history of the text and our limited knowledge about its intellectual backgrounds this volume gathers contributions by leading specialists in the fields of classical chinese philosophy philology logic and linguistics besides an overview of the scholarly literature on the topic and a detailed account of the reception of the text throughout time it presents fresh insights into philological and philosophical problems raised by the gongsun longzi and other closely related texts equally attributed to the school of names

influence it these texts dating from the late fifth century bce to the second century ce have been part of the scholarly debate on ancient afterlife beliefs since the end of the nineteenth century recent finds and analysis of the texts have reshaped our understanding of their purpose and of the perceived afterlife the tablets belonged to those who had been initiated into the mysteries of dionysus bacchius and relied heavily upon myths narrated in poems ascribed to the mythical singer orpheus after providing the greek text and a translation of all the available tablets the authors analyze their role in the mysteries of dionysus and present an outline of the myths concerning the origins of humanity and of the sacred texts that the greeks ascribed to orpheus related ancient texts are also appended in english translations providing the first book length edition and discussion of these enigmatic texts in english and their first english translation this book is essential to the study of ancient greek religion
