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dangerous diplomacy reassesses the role of the un secretariat during the rwandan genocide with the help of new sources including the personal diaries and private papers of the late sir marrack goulding an under secretary general from 1988 to 1997 and the second highest ranking un official during the genocide the book situates the rwanda operation within the context of bureaucratic and power political friction existing at un headquarters in the early 1990s the book shows how this confrontation led to a lack of coordination between key un departments on issues as diverse as reconnaissance intelligence and crisis management yet dangerous diplomacy goes beyond these institutional pathologies and identifies the conceptual origins of the rwanda failure in the gray area that separates peacebuilding and peacekeeping the difficulty of separating these two un functions

explains why six decades after the birth of the UN it has still not been possible to demarcate the precise roles of some key UN departments

contemporary relations between greater China and Japan have been conditioned both by differing responses to the impact of western colonialism during the mid nineteenth century and the legacy of the cold war there are mutual suspicions the Chinese fear of a Japanese military revival and the Japanese concern over increasing Chinese economic competition and territorial ambitions Robert Taylor recognises the mistrust in Sino Japanese relations but also sees shared advantages in this traditionally adversarial relationship the Chinese are currently modelling their economic strategy on Japan's developmental experience even though China's policies and institutions have distinctive features and differing agendas the study also examines the growing momentum towards sub regional integration rivalry between greater China and Japan is giving way to competition between regional economic blocks and corporate entities greater China and Japan explores the ambiguous relationship between the two countries and states that its development is crucial to the future of the region in the twenty first century

pension fund turned into a world class tourist attraction that helped change the image and boost the economy of an entire state the pension fund was the retirement systems of alabama and its alternative investment was in a string of golf courses and affiliated high end hotels and spas in business speak this was an economically targeted investment designed to diversify returns create jobs and increase tax revenue twenty five years later the robert trent jones golf trail is known worldwide for the quality and beauty of its courses and the hospitality and elegance of its resorts it has significantly increased alabama s infrastructure for tourism and conventions provided millions upon millions in new tax revenues spurred construction of thousands of units of adjacent housing and helped persuade other businesses to locate in the state making the golf trail a reality involved not only the initial vision of ceo david g bronner and his associates at rsa but also the design genius and reputation of robert trent jones sr and the hard work of many dedicated engineers and builders it also required the cooperation of scores of local and state elected officials and economic developers this book is the illustrated historical account of the financial legal political and economic impact details of rsa s investment in the rtj golf trail such a detailed history could not have been written without the years of economic analysis conducted by author mark fagan dating back to the earliest stages of the concept fagan s ongoing involvement with dr bronner and those working to develop the trail made possible the mammoth one of a kind history that is presented in this book

war speak the language of the military can be for many civilians and for members of differing services an unintelligible hodgepodge of acronyms slang terms and field operation expressions few laypersons may know that the five f's is a derogatory expression though army navy marine air force coast guard and others know or can infer that chairborn commandos are administrative and support personnel the more than 15 000 entries in this comprehensive dictionary provide an inside look at the united states military weapons systems governmental agencies electronic warfare medical terms military infrastructure communications satellites and intelligence systems are among the topics covered in depth also detailed are the acronyms and slang terms used by the soldiers in the field the work provides numerous cross references for ease of use along with a bibliography of over 2 200 sources

is there interaction between love and work if so in what ways does it appear the main incentive for this research is the notable increase of american and dutch people who wish to spend more and more of their time working and who feel useless and robbed of their identity when separated from their jobs it seems that work is considered more fulfilling and satisfying than love which can be undermined by failing relationships tension depression violence addiction crime or angry and unmanageable children whereas proust described love in a milieu where most of the work was

done by servants and artists freud was convinced that love and work were the two main pillars of society this view has been echoed by psychologists sociologists philosophers and novelists however a new phenomenon is that men and women share love and work finding the right balance between the two is a hot topic in how to books newspaper and magazine articles but the underlying connections have received little if any scrutiny in fact it may well be a mission impossible since as the frankfurt school asserted the capitalist powers in search of profit urge politicians to lure men women and children onto the work floor by telling them work is a duty that not only will provide disposable income but also happiness and fulfillment in life hence people internalize this message without asking themselves why continuous consumption is more important than giving and receiving love which they crave but seldom find although focusing on middle class people between the ages of twenty five and forty who are travelling the highway of life have paid jobs a relationship of at least three years and children this study should be of interest to everyone

western nations this process of creating a global culture through the propagation of western political and philosophical constructs as world brands poses grave dangers for the entire international community as countries become aware of their exploitation the possibilities for frustration and violence become increasingly real power of a third kind is directed toward western and non western leaders alike for the former it provides a new perspective from outside the mirror of our western culture pointing out that current practices are actually endangering the security of our hemisphere the author calls on western leaders to work on a dialogue with other societies as an alternative to exporting to them a monologue designed for passive absorption and for the latter this book will inspire them to steer out of their current course in time to protect their histories and the integrity of their cultures through meaningful dialogue well meaning nations will find a way for the most beneficial aspects of western culture self rule and basic human rights to evolve within the context of local cultures resulting in a world both more stable and more humane

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
