the psychology of dental care second edition provides information pertinent to the sociological aspects of dentistry this book discusses the needs of patients who require particular forms of care thereby helping the general dental practitioner to deal with nervous patients and enhance communication skills organized into seven chapters this edition begins with an overview of some of the problems that dentists encounter in managing patients this text then explains the importance of preventive care in oral health which includes both educational and motivational approaches other chapters provide suggestions for designing a preventive program that can be adapted for the use of individual patients this book discusses as well the various ways of measuring pain which is important for the understanding of psychological approaches to pain relief the final chapter deals with the dentist s attitudes behavior and personality that are important for the understanding of dental care this book is a valuable resource for dentists and psychologists

this book aims to provide the dental team with an improved understanding of management of the oral health needs of the ageing population in whom increasing cognitive medical and physical disabilities impact significantly on oral health and dental care needs all significant aspects of caring for older people are covered the nature and implications of changing demographics are explained and information provided on common medical co morbidities and the impact of cognitive conditions including dementia on dental treatment the changing pattern of dental disease in older people is clearly described with explanation of the consequences of these changes for aspects of restorative dentistry oral medicine and oral surgery advice is given on considerations for dental treatment planning including the importance of prevention and utilization of dental care professionals provision of care for older people under general anaesthesia or sedation and domiciliary care are also covered the book is written by specialist practicing clinicians and delivers information in an accessible way with a person centered approach

in the mid 1970s when this book was published dental care in america below the crisis level was confined almost exclusively to the upper and upper middle classes with perhaps the highest standards in the world for dental care this country has done an unnecessarily poor job of distributing that care widely and efficiently why in this book dr dunning examines not only the organization of dental care private practice clinics health centers and the use of auxiliary personnel but also payment systems such as voluntary insurance plans that are widening the market for dental care he proposes improvements ranging from an increased use of portable dental equipment to large scale reorganizations of dental practice this would make dental care appropriate to need available to everyone when he wrote this book dr dunning was professor of ecological dentistry emeritus and harvard university

this excellent new work confronts two important oral health policy concerns in the united states the disparities in the oral disease burden and the inability of certain segments of the population to access oral health care the book examines in depth this crucial yet frequently overlooked indicator of seniors quality of life it provides an invaluable set of recommendations to the clinical research and administrative communities that will serve the elderly population

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
