effect on adjustment to a new school and they discuss the influence of teacher peer and parent support on successful readjustment by documenting the methodology and outcomes of the school transition project a four year federally funded preventive intervention program for transfer students the authors show how schools can mount cost effective programs to teach students the skills they need to succeed at new schools
