relation between the state and smaller churches since sabrina petra ramet pointed out the protestant churches were more troublesome for the communists than the orthodox church or catholic church therefore i consider it most interesting to compare the ecclesial situations of the orthodox church and the protestant churches in romania during the communist era and under the communist regime
