the language literature provides a framework for analysing language it explores how writers use literary language to create literary texts and helps students use language successfully in their own writing key features covers key skills and topics in

the language and literature reader is an invaluable resource for students of english literature language and linguistics bringing together the most significant work in the field with integrated editorial material this reader is a structured and accessible tool for the student and scholar divided into three

sections foundations developments and new directions the reader provides an overview of the discipline from the early stages in the 1960s and 70s through the new theories and practices of the 1980s and 90s to the most recent and contemporary work in the field each article contains a brief introduction by the editors situating it in the context of developing work in the discipline and glossing it in terms of the section and of the book as a whole the final section concludes with a history and manifesto written by the editors which places developments in the area of stylistics within a brief history of the field and offers a polemical perspective on the future of a growing and influential discipline

literature language and politics brings together papers drawn from and inspired by the controversial landmark symposium on politics and the discipline held at the 1987 modern language association meeting in san francisco during the 1980s debates raged both within and outside academe over curriculum with conservatives arguing for a return to an educational philosophy based on the classics of western civilization and a multi cultural coalition of liberals leftists and feminists seeking to preserve the diversity of educational experience fought for since the 1960s engaging this crucial debate the contributors to literature language and politics argue that the conservative educational agenda imperils not only scholarship and academic freedom but the very social well being of the nation they call for firm resistance to any attempts to make education conform to the social agenda of one race one gender one language or one ideology for a continuation of attempts to broaden the curriculum until it reflects the experience of women and men of all classes and all cultures includes essays by henry louis gates jr gerald graff annette kolodny paul lauter ellen messer davidow catharine r stimpson and ana celia zentella

literature language and multiculturalism in scandinavia and the low countries presents a ground breaking comparative approach to the study of multicultural literature focusing on the development of migration literature in sweden denmark flanders and the netherlands the volume argues that the political and institutional preconditions for the development of multicultural literatures are still given within the frame of the nation state as a consequence both the field of migration literature and the multi lingual quality of literary texts are shaped differently in each state and in each language area the volume delineates the development of multicultural literature in scandinavia and the low countries as a function of the specific language situations in these countries as well as the various political institutional and discursive contexts this book not only offers a comprehensive theoretical and methodological analysis of multilingualism and multicultural literature but also provides overviews sketching the discourse on multiculturalism language and the development of the literary field in sweden denmark the netherlands and flanders besides it presents a broad range of in depth analyses of selected literary texts from each of these countries

studying language through literature invites readers to reconsider the opportunity represented by literary texts for language related purposes despite the close relationship between literature and language in educational contexts literature is frequently associated with teaching practices which have been judged to be unsuccessful subsequently texts of the non literary type are preferred on the basis that they are authentic and closer to real language the

everlasting relationship between language and literature is here reassessed starting from two assumptions literature is the expression of an emphasized perception of reality be it private collective or pertaining to a certain temporal spatial context and literary language is language in its utmost form following an outline of the philosophy that governs the book each chapter presents specific insights on the use of the various different literary genres namely fiction poetry and drama the opportunities offered by translation in the foreign language classroom constitute a recurrent theme throughout the book although chapter 5 is entirely devoted to translation criticism the closing pages put forward a few reflections on assessment while offering some food for thought in order to reassess the role of literature in the language class this book puts together ideas considerations and suggestions from which the reader is free to pick mix and adjust exploiting them to her his greatest benefit

this book presents an introduction to stylistics for students of literature it does not presuppose linguistic knowledge but it approaches literature in a linguistic way in the first half it looks at the make up of a sentence in english and how sentence elements are exploited by literary authors in the second half it looks at the way in which a text is unified by elements beyond the sentence the conclusion exemplifies the theory explained in the previous chapters

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
