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the questions of metaphysics are the deepest and most puzzling questions there are what is time am i free in my actions what makes me the same person i was as a child what is it for one thing to cause another riddles of existence is the first book ever to make metaphysics genuinely accessible and fun its lively informal style brings the riddles to life and shows how stimulating it can be to think about them no philosophical background is required to enjoy this book anyone who has thought about life s most profound questions will find plenty to provoke and entertain them here

for millennia humanity has worshipped an all powerful all knowing deity a being said to exist beyond time logic and imperfection yet the more we examine this idea the more fragile it becomes in one thing god can t do kunal kapoor invites readers into a philosophical and emotional journey that challenges traditional theology with sharp reason and human insight from the paradox of omnipotence to the moral contradictions of scripture kapoor reveals that the supposed perfection of divinity is neither rational nor necessary the book argues that meaning love and creativity thrive not in the absence of limits but because of them profoundly skeptical yet deeply human this work encourages readers to think freely question sacred norms and rediscover wonder in imperfection

the overcoming of death is a serious undertaking because death is a part of the nature one one s being and therefore not what it appears to be when death is reconciled with life it becomes a means of interdimensional travel we realize that it wasnt there in the first place therefore the overcoming of death is to take place within one s present consciousness for death is the counterpart of life in the first place therefore the resurrection unto life is from the death that is hidden in life it is the dead that appear to be living that are resurrected unto life death is something that is a part of ones present consciousness not something off somewhere in the so called afterlife the resurrection of the dead is unto conscious life or immortality or back into the realm of unconscious death for life and death occupy the same space it is a matter of seeing death as it is not just as it appears to be in that death is not what it appears to be the overcoming of death is not what it appears to be therefore it is a real possibility it can be realized within ones lifetime the overcoming of death is the means of bringing the realization of conscious immortality to the awareness of ones present consciousness in this lifetime it reveals why it is that losing life is finding it and how it is that it is the dead that are living that hear the voice of the son of god and are resurrected from the dead

the doctrine of god is central to theology for it determines the way in which other regions of christian doctrine are articulated yet work on this topic in its own right has been occluded recently by treatments of the trinity or divine passibility this collection of specially commissioned essays presents major treatments of key themes in the doctrine of god motivated by but not restricted to the work of professor paul s fiddes to whom it is offered as a festschrift it includes invigorating discussions of the biblical and non biblical sources for the doctrine of god and the section on metaphysics and the doctrine of god examines some of the most important conceptual questions arising in contemporary theological debate about the being and nature of god and god s relations to the world the final section of the book on god and humanity will be highly relevant to scholars working in the fields of theological anthropology moral and political theology on inter faith relations

how ought christian faith and theology understand the concept of human immortality today and what if anything might be distinctively christian about such a concept the contributors to this volume explore how our thinking about the prospect of human immortality is decisively determined by what we receive of the limitless life of the triune god of the gospel and how our understanding of immortality is made concrete by the christian hope in the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting debates about how best to understand the eternal life of god are directly significant to how we can imagine the promise of eternal life while immortality is generally conceived to be a future qualification of human reality theological approaches to the question of personal immortality must investigate the difference that the hope and promise of such eternal life makes in the living of present day spiritual life as well as in our common moral and political existence to understand immortality as an eschatological gift of god requires that we take account of it as a formative factor at the foundations of the christian life

in most societies of the world including in africa responsibility for the material support of older people unable to sustain themselves through work or investments originally resided with their younger generational family members especially their adult children aboderin explores this topic specifically for africa in the wake of social or economic change societies experience shifts in the degree to which families support their elders questions about the proper balance of family and state responsibility however persist especially in light of socio demographic trends and constraints in public expenditure in most of sub saharan africa in contrast to other world regions economic security policies for older people have not yet been formulated despite declines in material family support along with rising poverty to which a growing elderly population is exposed in part this betrays the crucial lack of understanding about how and why these shifts in support have occurred in african societies and thus a profound uncertainty about what balance of individual family and state responsibilities will be culturally appropriate and effective in ensuring economic security for older africans both now and in the future aboderin aims to address these gaps in understanding she provides an empirical and theoretical analysis of the micro and macro level processes that have underpinned recent declines in old age family support in african societies and likely parameters of future familial support she also addresses more fundamental theoretical questions about how we should think about the relationships between intergenerational support norms and values and societal change intergenerational support in africa will be of interest to students of african studies economic policy and theory concerning eldercare sociology and social welfare development
