Well aware of the limitations placed upon women advocating for reform in a patriarchal legal system, Constance Backhouse recreates vivid and textured snapshots of these and other women's courageous struggles against gender discrimination and oppression, employing social history to illuminate the reproductive, sexual, racial and occupational inequalities that continue to shape women's encounters with the law. *Petticoats and Prejudice* is an essential entry point into the gendered treatment of feminized bodies in Canadian legal institutions.
