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in cosmology and fate in gnosticism and graeco roman antiquity nicola denzey lewis dismisses hans jonas mischaracterization of second century gnosticism as a philosophically oriented religious movement built on the perception of the cosmos as negative or enslaving a focused study on the concept of astrological fate in gnostic writings including the apocryphon of john the recently discovered gospel of judas trimorphic protennoia and the pistis sophia this book reexamines their language of enslavement to fate gk heimarmene from its origins in greek stoicism its deployment by the apostle paul to its later use by a variety of second century intellectuals both christian and non christian denzey lewis thus offers an informed and revisionist conceptual map of the ancient cosmos its influence and all those who claimed to be free of its potentially pernicious effects

lisa bellantoni argues that contemporary bioethics divides into two logically incommensurable positions a cult of rights which identifies the worth of human life with our autonomy and a cult of life which identifies human worth with the possession of a soul and thereby of human dignity

in the context of what begins as a lengthy critique of classic roman religion and a defense of christianity augustine touches upon numerous topics including the role of grace the original state of humanity the possibility of waging a just war the ideal form of government and the nature of heaven and hell

this volume gathers together about two thirds of the articles and essays published between 1983 and 2021 by philip hardie whose work on ancient literature has been of seminal importance in the field the centre of gravity lies in late republican and augustan poetry in particular lucretius virgil and ovid with important contributions on wider augustan culture on neronian and flavian epic on the latin poetry of late antiquity and on the reception of latin poetry

the eloquent and uncompromising calls for social righteousness by the minor prophets are familiar to many yet the writings themselves are probably the least studied and least known texts of the old testament those who are familiar with these books are also aware of the historical and literary problems that plague their study drawing on theological historical and literary insights leslie allen s commentary on joel obadiah jonah and micah carefully and imaginatively reconstructs the context in which the original hebrew audience received the prophets messages in turn allen shows what relevance they hold for contemporary christians for each of the books allen includes a substantial introduction presenting and assessing a broad range of scholarship a select bibliography and an extensive commentary on the author s own translation of the text allen pays special attention to micah in which he treats at greater length many of the forms and motifs that also appear in joel obadiah and jonah the introductory material for joel includes discussions of canonicity and textual criticism that apply to the entire volume

though stylistics undoubtedly plays a crucial role in the scholarship on latin poetry from commentaries to textual criticism from intertextuality to literary criticism in recent years for various reasons it has not received the attention it deserves this book published a generation after adams and mayer's seminal 1999 volume aspects of the language of latin poetry ideally aims to complement and update it on a smaller scale offering the reader a collection of stimulating papers from international scholars on the style of some of the most significant voices of latin poetry from early drama to the flavian period

one purpose of this memoir is to describe to my sons matthew and alexander granddaughters sophia and juliet and any future grandchildren the driving forces that determined my destiny i have often toyed with the idea of writing my memoir but the writing would never have happened if not for the deaths of my father jim in 2002 mother ruby in 2006 beloved twin brother larry in 2008 and treasured wife edith in 2009 i realized that the memories of these special people would be lost forever if i did not commit them to paper as soon as possible our lives are finite and our accomplishments seem ephemeral thus in comparison to the seemingly ageless universe the details of our lives appear to be mere vanity

rogues published in france under the title voyous comprises two major lectures that derrida delivered in 2002 investigating the foundations of the sovereignty of the nation state the term État voyou is the french equivalent of rogue state and it is this outlaw designation of certain countries by the leading global powers that derrida rigorously and exhaustively examines derrida examines the history of the concept of sovereignty engaging with the work of bodin hobbes rousseau schmitt and others against this background he delineates his understanding of democracy to come which he distinguishes clearly from any kind of regulating ideal or teleological horizon the idea that democracy will always remain in the future is not a temporal notion rather the phrase would name the coming of the unforeseeable other the structure of an event beyond calculation and program derrida thus aligns this understanding of democracy with the logic he has worked out elsewhere but it is not just political philosophy that is brought under deconstructive scrutiny here derrida provides unflinching and hard hitting assessments of current political realities and these essays are highly engaged with events of the post 9 11 world
