less about the body politic of the monarch and more about colonial pursuits and pressing environmental issues as tigner identifies during this period literary representations of gardens become potent discursive models that both inspire constructions of their aesthetic principles and reflect innovations in horticulture and garden technology further the development of the botanical garden ushers in a new world of science and exploration with the importation of a new world of plants the garden emerges as a locus of scientific study hybridization medical investigation and the proliferation of new ornamentals and aliments in this way the garden functions as a means to understand and possess the rapidly expanding globe
