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young adults are actively looking for anything that connects them with the changes happening in their lives and the books discussed throughout literature for young adults have the potential to make that connection and motivate them to read it explores a great variety of works genres and formats but it places special emphasis on contemporary works whose nontraditional themes protagonists and literary conventions make them well suited to young adult readers it also looks at the ways in which contemporary readers access and share the works they re reading and it shows teachers ways to incorporate nontraditional ways of accessing and sharing books throughout their literature programs in addition to traditional genre chapters literature for young adults includes chapters on literary nonfiction poetry short stories and drama cover art picture books illustrated literature and graphic novels and film it recognizes that while films can be used to complement print literature they are also a literacy format in their own right and one that young adults are particularly familiar and comfortable with the book s discussion of literary language including traditional elements as well as metafictional terms enables readers to share in a literary conversation with their students and others when communicating about books it will help readers teach young adults the language they need to articulate their responses to the books they are reading

she has it all wealth beauty and fame she also carries an eternal flame it burns within her heart and threatens

in a split second by catherine rosch in catherine rosch s book she shares the journey she and her husband have experienced after her husband has a tragic fall while on the job suffering a traumatic brain injury their lives are changed forever in a split second rosch shares the daily struggles and the dark times her family has had to fight through after giving it their all and overcoming the difficult challenges rosch hopes that her husband s struggles and inspiring story will give hope and courage to others suffering from a traumatic brain injury

in this pulitzer prize winning classic a convicted killer becomes the first prisoner to be executed in the united states the executioner s song follows the true story of cold blooded murderer gary gilmore who after being tried and convicted insisted on being executed for his crimes to do so he fought a system intent on keeping him alive long after it sentenced him to death norman mailer tells gilmore s story with impressive authority and compassion the executioner s song is a trip down the wrong side of the tracks right into the heart of american loneliness and violence it is impossible to put down and difficult to forget

a new sports movie with a new twist about a failing major league baseball team the runaway boys that is a screwball comedy about the trials and tribulations about a computer billionaire whiz kid ryan green the new owner of a baseball team takes a chance on a misfit player like mike riley an ex superstar pitcher from this club was sent to the minors two years ago and hasnt been back ever since roger punjaab an indian american doctor who works for his father decided to join the majors david yoder an ex communicated amish boy from lancaster decided to leave the community to play in the baseball league jeff riley rileys father who was a junior college baseball star who became an architect and took his little league baseball team that his firm sponsored to a little league championship he got laid off from his job for six months and was offered to be a manager of the big leagues and matt schultz a college baseball and cape league star who ended up as a librarian in the new york public library dreams about playing in the baseball league he was invited to spring training by accident when there was another schultz that was invited to spring training these are the players he invites to camp who can turn this team around with a two year losing streak against a greedy corporate raider named dalton reynolds who hates the yondala and wants to tear down the stadium build condos and hotels that will make him a fortune ryan is on a mission to save his team from a greedy investor who made a

bet if this failing team wins the pennant he will invest a lot of money in the team and if he loses hell tear it down the chances of winning the pennant is a million to one but i hope the fans and the city are ready for them

a small town psychic s trailer burns leaving little in the wreckage but her lovely green couch a great find for a couple who make their living scavenging and selling secondhand items yet madame cruller s couch is imbedded with something unpleasant and we re not talking fleas a young man accompanied by a shadowy specter since birth unwittingly exacts revenge against those who threaten him a hoarder learns that dogs can sometimes be loyal to a fault a dark and terrible secret threatens the plans two brothers have of racing their car in a television themed challenge a pony and a steer have had enough of their arrogant owners and decide to take the bull by the horns so to speak thanks to the couple who own her town christmastime has become an annoyance for donna wilson but during this year s command performance yuletide party donna discovers a nightmare that rivals any holiday horror story she s ever read surviving the brutal 1968 vietnam war riots in chicago a desperately optimistic man travels cross country to join a commune only to realize that peace can be as dangerous as violence a peculiar and devastating plague rapidly spreads across the globe throwing the survivors into a battle for their sanity and their lives these are some of the stories in this chilling new collection by two time bram stoker award winning author elizabeth massie elizabeth massie is personally one of my favorite authors bentley little author of the town the bank elizabeth massie never fails to engage the heart and mind jack ketchum author of the girl next door the lost

this referential collection of essays is an important guide to the emergence and development of literary journalism through the centuries the book begins with the defining of genres literature and journalism which blur the lines between them it also gives an insight into the theories of narratology some practitioners included in this book are great american writers like john hersey truman capote norman mailer and don delillo these literary journalists bring to life both major as well trivial issues of the society new journalists coalesce all the fictional techniques with the journalistic methods to present a unique and sophisticated style which requires extensive research and even more careful reporting than done in the typical news articles the book closes with the concluding thoughts followed by list of works cited
