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everyone knows the wind's touch its presence its force sometimes it roars and howls at other times we hear its wistful sighs and feel its soothing caresses since antiquity humans have borne witness to the wind and relied on it to navigate the seas and yet despite its

presence at the heart of human experience the wind has evaded scrutiny in our chronicles of the past in this brilliantly original volume alain corbin sets out to illuminate the wind's storied history he shows how before the nineteenth century the noisy emptiness of wind was experienced and described only according to the sensations it provoked imagery of the wind featured prominently in literature from the ancient greek epics through the renaissance and romanticism to the modern era but little was known about where the wind came from and where it went it was only in the late eighteenth century with the discovery of the composition of air that scientists began to understand the nature of wind and its trajectories from that point on our understanding of the wind was shaped by meteorology which mapped the flows of winds and currents around the globe but while science has enabled us to understand the wind and in some respects to harness it the wind has lost nothing of its mysterious force it still has the power to destroy and in the wind's ethereal presence we can still feel its connection with creation and death

recycling the remnants of the literary text verandas for the residual and the emergent addresses literary recycling as a creative endeavour that supplements meaning through appropriating remnants of texts and transforming them into traces or echoes of their former selves within a new narrative design it approaches recycling as a process that extends verandas of meanings and creates sites for ongoing discursive accretion of signification through the dialogic encounter between the old and the new the residual and the emergent whether seen as markers of the capacity of the literary text to surprise and haunt its readers or residues of systems of representations predicated on selective inclusion and strategies of exclusion remnants can offer rich material for setting in motion new cycles of renewal the contributors of this volume propose recycling as writing and reading strategies the first grants the remnants an afterlife and allow for an opening up of new narrative possibilities while the second constructs alternative readings by allowing unwanted remnants to return and fill in gaps and silences these oddments of the literary text are essential to question the iniquities of cultural racial and class prejudices they are unavoidable in the construction of an emergent literary and cultural matrix for disruption and change

like roland barthes well known book *L'empire des signes* from which the title of the present collection is taken this volume contains essays dealing with certain aspects of japanese culture

for decades research on children's literacy has been dominated by questions of how

children learn to read especially among anglophone scholars cognitive and psycholinguistic research on reading has been the only approach to studying written language education echoing this debates on methods of teaching children to read have long dominated the educational scene this book presents an alternative view in recent years writing has emerged as a central aspect of becoming literate research in cognitive psychology has shown that writing is a highly complex activity involving a degree of planning unknown in everyday conversational uses of language at the same time developmental studies have revealed that when young children are asked to write they show a surprisingly sophisticated understanding of the representational constraints of alphabetic writing systems they show this understanding long before they can read conventional writing on their own the rich structure of meanings involved in the word text provided the glue that brought together a group of scholars from several disciplines in an international workshop held in rome reflecting the state of the field at the time the majority of the workshop participants were scholars working in languages other than english especially the romance languages their work mirrors a linguistic and psychological research tradition that anglophone scholars knew little of until recently this volume provides english language readers with updated versions of the papers presented at the meeting the topics discussed at the workshop are represented in the chapters as follows the relationship between acquisition of language and familiarity with written texts the reciprocal permeability between spoken and written language the initial phases of text construction by children and the educational conditions that facilitate written language acquisition and writing practice

this anthology brought together the most important historical legal mythological liturgical and secular texts of the ancient near east with the purpose of providing a rich contextual base for understanding the people cultures and literature of the old testament a scholar of religious thought and biblical archaeology james pritchard recruited the foremost linguists historians and archaeologists to select and translate the texts the goal in his words was a better understanding of the likenesses and differences which existed between israel and the surrounding cultures before the publication of these volumes students of the old testament found themselves having to search out scattered books and journals in various languages this anthology brought these invaluable documents together in one place and in one language thereby expanding the meaning and significance of the bible for generations of students and readers as one reviewer put it this great volume is one of the most notable to have appeared in the field of old testament scholarship this century princeton published a follow up companion volume the ancient near east in pictures relating to the old

testament 1954 and later a one volume abridgment of the two the ancient near east an anthology of texts and pictures 1958 the continued popularity of this work in its various forms demonstrates that anthologies have a very important role to play in education and in the mission of a university press

this book attempts to clarify the concept of literary classification first within the larger framework of aesthetic classification and then with reference to literary theories

the norwegian composer ludvig irgens jensen 1894 1969 was one of the towering creative figures of his native land although his dignified and powerful music is only now beginning to receive the attention its quality deserves the success of his dramatic symphony heimferd æhomecoming in 1930 brought him national fame but the post war triumph of modernism coupled with his personal modesty pushed irgens jensen s tonal music into the shadows its contrapuntally based textures and its modally tinged harmonies were seen as things of the past but a growing number of recordings is reminding listeners that he was one of the most distinguished and distinctive voices in twentieth century music a figure of international importance writing music of striking nobility and strength of purpose with some meltingly lovely melodic lines

first published in 2011 this text provides citations to the core holst literature the volume is intended for students and researchers as well as those seeking an introduction to holst the inclusion of materials for the non specialist seems entirely appropriate as holst devoted much of his career to teaching amateur musicians the contents of this book presents a selective annotated list of essential materials published through the end of 2009 although a very few exceptions were made for a limited number of post 2009 print and web resources

the astronomy of the carolingian era has commonly been represented as concerned

exclusively with computus the science of calendar construction as well as arithmetical calculation in general this volume shows the error of that portrayal by exploring the study and teaching of four roman texts on astronomy and cosmology in the carolingian world and the diagrams connected to those texts as each of these works came into use over the carolingian era its contributions merged into a progressively more ordered picture of the heavens both eccentrics and epicycles appeared by the 840s these techniques were subsequently introduced clearly and qualitatively to complete the carolingian enterprise the primary tool for understanding this effort is the analysis of their diagrams medieval and early modern science vol 8

among the rituals kept in the archives of the hittite capital more than twenty are concerned with birth and its difficulties this work transliterates and translates these texts and provides them with a commentary discussing anthropological as well as philological questions an introduction sketches the treatment of birth in hittite texts of various genres while a summary outlines hittite obstetric practice as it may be reconstructed from all available cuneiform sources one chapter is devoted to the character and the role of the human personnel and divinities attendant at birth and particular attention is given to the vexing problem of the dingir mah mes hi a glossary of the vocabulary appearing in the hittite birth rituals is included
