intersecting identities and structures particularly novel are the specific insights into disability race class social age and gender identity situating canada within broader international trends norms and structures both today and historically forced migration in to canada provides the tools we need to evaluate information we encounter in the news and from government officials colleagues and non governmental organizations it also proposes new areas for enquiry discussion research advocacy and action
