maya s notebook is a startling novel of suspense from new york times bestselling author isabel allende this contemporary coming of age story centers upon maya vidal a remarkable teenager abandoned by her parents maya grew up in a rambling old house

in berkeley with her grandmother nini whose formidable strength helped her build a new life after emigrating from chile in 1973 with a young son and her grandfather popo a gentle african american astronomer when popo dies maya goes off the rails along with a circle of girlfriends known as the vampires she turns to drugs alcohol and petty crime a downward spiral that eventually leads to las vegas and a dangerous underworld with maya caught between warring forces a gang of assassins the police the fbi and interpol her one chance for survival is nini who helps her escape to a remote island off the coast of chile in the care of her grandmother s old friend manuel arias and surrounded by strange new acquaintances maya begins to record her story in her notebook as she tries to make sense of her past and unravel the mysteries of her family and her own life

the source of the narrative energy that creates such absorbing stories allende s very popular novels have attracted both critical approval and opprobrium often at the expense of genuine analysis this sophisticated study explores the narrative architecture of allende s *house of the spirits* 1982 *daughter of fortune* 1999 and *portrait in sepia* 2000 as a trilogy proposing that the places created in these novels subvert the patriarchal norms that have governed politics sexuality and ethnicity rooted in the foucauldian premise that the history of space is essentially the history of power and supported by susan stanford friedman s cultural geographies of encounter as well as gloria anzaldúa s study of borderlands this study shows that by rejecting traditional spatial hierarchies allende s trilogy systematically deterritorializes the elite while shifting the previously marginalized to the physical and thematic centers of her works this movement provides the narrative energy which draws the reader into allende s universe and sustains the good story for which she has been universally acclaimed karen wooley martin is associate professor of spanish at union university jackson tennessee

isabel allende is considered latin america s most acclaimed woman writer a status she has archived by imbuing her work with a mixture of history and fiction that both educates and entertains readers in this book levine examines allende s success in uniting quality writing with mass appeal she looks at allende s use of a feminist agenda her ability to combine genres as varied as the adventure story and the romance novel and the important roles historical data and sociological insights play in framing her narratives while most scholarship on allende focuses on her early novels levin s study touches on the full catalog of allende s work supplementing the text are an interview with allende a preface chronology notes and references selected bibliography and index

isabel allende evokes the magnificent landscapes of her country a charming idiosyncratic chilean people with a violent history and an indomitable spirit and the politics religion myth and magic of her homeland that she carries with her even today the book circles around two life changing moments the assassination of her uncle salvador allende gossens on september 11 1973 sent her into exile and transformed her into a literary writer and the terrorist attacks of september 11 2001 on her adopted

homeland the united states brought forth an overdue acknowledgment that allende had indeed left home my invented country mimicking the workings of memory itself ranges back and forth across that distance between past and present lives it speaks compellingly to immigrants and to all of us who try to retain a coherent inner life in a world full of contradictions

in 1843 a baby is left on the doorstep of rose summers and her brother jeremy who live in the british colony of valparaiso chile rose names the baby eliza and raises her as part of the family when eliza falls in love with joaqu  n andieta one of jeremy s delivery boys news of the gold in california has just reached chile joaqu  n caught up in the popular fever sets out to make a fortune up north leaving behind eliza now pregnant with his child spirited and with a mind of her own eliza leaves her home in valparaiso and undertakes a dangerous sea voyage to san francisco in search of her lover what she finds instead is adversity and adventure and through her own resourcefulness an even more momentous journey to independence and freedom when she finally hears news of joaqu  n eliza must decide who her true love really is

here in an astonishing debut by a gifted storyteller is the magnificent saga of proud and passionate men and women and the turbulent times through which they suffer and triumph they are the truebas and theirs is a world you will not want to leave and one you will not forget esteban the patriarch a volatile and proud man whose lust for land is legendary and who is haunted by his tyrannical passion for the wife he can never completely possess clara the matriarch elusive and mysterious who foretells family tragedy and shapes the fortunes of the house of the truebas blanca their daughter soft spoken yet rebellious whose shocking love for the son of her father s foreman fuels esteban s everlasting contempt even as it produces the grandchild he adores alba the fruit of blanca s forbidden love a luminous beauty a fiery and willful woman the family s break with the past and link to the future
