IN THIS WORK OF INTELLECTUAL HISTORY THE AUTHOR IDENTIFIES FOUR TRANSFORMATIONS IN FEDERAL GOVERNMENT THAT FOLLOWED THE NEW DEAL THE RISE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE STATE THE EROSION OF FEDERALISM THE ASCENDANCE OF THE MODERN PRESIDENCY AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF MODERN JUDICIAL REVIEW HE THEN CONSIDERS HOW SCHOOLS OF CONSERVATIVE THOUGHT TRADITIONALISTS NEOCONSERVATIVES LIBERTARIANS STRAUSSIANS RESPONDED TO EACH TRANSFORMATION

FROM HEALTHCARE TO WORKPLACE CONDUCT THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IS TAKING ON EVER MORE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANAGING OUR LIVES AT THE SAME TIME AMERICANS HAVE NEVER BEEN MORE DISAFFECTED WITH WASHINGTON SEEING IT AS AN INTRUSIVE INCOMPETENT WASTEFUL GIANT THE MOST ALARMING CONSEQUENCE OF INEFFECTIVE POLICIES IN

ADDITION TO UNREALIZED SOCIAL GOALS IS THE GROWING THREAT TO THE GOVERNMENT'S DEMOCRATIC LEGITIMACY. UNDERSTANDING WHY GOVERNMENT FAILS SO OFTEN AND HOW IT MIGHT BECOME MORE EFFECTIVE IS AN URGENT RESPONSIBILITY OF CITIZENSHIP. IN THIS BOOK, LAWYER AND POLITICAL SCIENTIST PETER SCHUCK PROVIDES A WIDE RANGE OF EXAMPLES AND AN ENORMOUS BODY OF EVIDENCE TO EXPLAIN WHY SO MANY DOMESTIC POLICIES GO AWRY AND HOW TO RIGHT THE FOUNDERING SHIP OF STATE. SCHUCK ARGUES THAT WASHINGTON'S FAILURES ARE DUE NOT TO EPISODIC PROBLEMS OR PARTISAN BICKERING BUT RATHER TO DEEP STRUCTURAL FLAWS THAT UNDERMINE EVERY ADMINISTRATION. DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN, THESE RECURRENT WEAKNESSES INCLUDE UNREALISTIC GOALS, PERVERSE INCENTIVES, POOR AND DISTORTED INFORMATION, SYSTEMIC IRRATIONALITY, RIGIDITY, AND LACK OF CREDIBILITY. A MEDIOCRE BUREAUCRACY, POWERFUL AND INESCAPABLE MARKETS, AND THE INHERENT LIMITS OF LAW TO COUNTERACT EACH OF THESE PROBLEMS. SCHUCK PROPOSES NUMEROUS ACHIEVABLE REFORMS, FROM AVOIDING MORAL HAZARD IN STUDENT LOAN, MORTGAGE, AND OTHER SUBSIDY PROGRAMS TO EMPOWERING CONSUMERS OF PUBLIC SERVICES, SIMPLIFYING PROGRAMS, AND TESTING THEM FOR COST EFFECTIVENESS AND INCREASING THE USE OF BIG DATA. THE BOOK ALSO EXAMINES SUCCESSFUL POLICIES, INCLUDING THE GI BILL, THE VOTING RIGHTS ACT, THE EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT, AND AIRLINE DEREGULATION, TO HIGHLIGHT THE FACTORS THAT MADE THEM WORK. AN URGENT CALL FOR REFORM, WHY GOVERNMENT FAILS SO OFTEN IS ESSENTIAL READING FOR ANYONE CURIOUS ABOUT WHY GOVERNMENT IS IN SUCH DISREPUTE AND HOW IT CAN DO BETTER.

FROM THE NUREMBERG TRIALS TO THE CIVIL SERVICE REFORM ACT OF 1978 TO RECENT BUDGET RECONCILIATION BILLS, THE ENCYCLOPEDIA OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AND PUBLIC POLICY PROVIDES DETAILED COVERAGE OF WATERSHED POLICIES AND DECISIONS FROM SUCH FIELDS AS PRIVATIZATION, BIOMEDICAL ETHICS, EDUCATION, AND DIVERSITY. THIS SECOND EDITION FEATURES A WIDE RANGE OF NEW TOPICS, INCLUDING MILITARY ADMINISTRATION, GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT, SOCIAL THEORY, AND JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION IN DEVELOPED DEMOCRACIES. IT ALSO ADDRESSES CURRENT ISSUES SUCH AS THE CREATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND COVERS PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION IN THE MIDDLE EAST, AFRICA, SOUTHEAST ASIA, THE PACIFIC, AND LATIN AMERICA.

KNOCKING ON THE DOOR IS THE FIRST BOOK-LENGTH WORK TO ANALYZE FEDERAL INVOLVEMENT IN RESIDENTIAL SEGREGATION FROM RECONSTRUCTION TO THE PRESENT, PROVIDING A PARTICULARLY DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE PERIOD 1968 TO 1973. THE BOOK EXAMINES HOW THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) ATTEMPTED TO FORGE ELEMENTARY CHANGES IN SEGREGATED RESIDENTIAL PATTERNS BY OPENING UP THE SUBURBS TO GROUPS HISTORICALLY EXCLUDED FOR RACIAL OR ECONOMIC REASONS. THE DOOR DID NOT SHUT COMPLETELY ON THIS POSSIBILITY UNTIL PRESIDENT RICHARD NIXON TOOK THE DRASTIC STEP OF FREEZING ALL FEDERAL HOUSING FUNDS IN JANUARY 1973. KNOCKING ON THE DOOR ASSESSES THIS NEAR MISS IN POLITICAL HISTORY, EXPLORING HOW HUD CAME SURPRISINGLY CLOSE TO IMPLEMENTING RIGOROUS ANTIDISCRIMINATION POLICIES AND WHY THE AGENCY'S EFFORTS WERE DERAILED BY NIXON. CHRISTOPHER BONASTIA SHOWS HOW THE NIXON YEARS WERE RIPE FOR FEDERAL ACTION TO FOSTER RESIDENTIAL DESEGREGATION. THE PERIOD WAS MARKED BY NEW LEGISLATIVE PROTECTIONS AGAINST HOUSING DISCRIMINATION, UNPRECEDENTED FEDERAL INVOLVEMENT IN HOUSING CONSTRUCTION, AND FREQUENT JUDICIAL BACKING FOR THE ACTIONS OF CIVIL RIGHTS AGENCIES. BY COMPARING HOUSING DESEGREGATION POLICIES TO CIVIL RIGHTS ENFORCEMENT IN EMPLOYMENT AND EDUCATION, BONASTIA OFFERS AN UNRIVALED ACCOUNT OF WHY CIVIL RIGHTS POLICIES DIVERGE SO SHARPLY IN THEIR AMBITION AND EFFECTIVENESS.

MOST AMERICAN CITIZENS ARE QUICK TO CRITICIZE FEDERAL BUREAUCRACY FOR ITS SIZE AND INEFFICIENCY THEY ASSUME IT HAS EXCEEDED THE INTENT OF OUR NATION S FOUNDERS YET MEN LIKE JAMES MADISON AND ALEXANDER HAMILTON KNEW THAT GOOD PUBLIC ADMINISTRATORS WERE ESSENTIAL TO GOOD GOVERNMENT WILLIAM RICHARDSON HERE EXAMINES THE ORIGINS LEGITIMACY AND LIMITATIONS OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION FROM THE PERSPECTIVE OF THE FOUNDERS THOUGHT HE SHOWS THAT THESE MEN ESPECIALLY THE AUTHORS OF THE FEDERALIST ADVOCATED AN ENERGETIC PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION AS AN ESSENTIAL COMPONENT OF GOVERNMENT AND EVEN CONSIDERED THE EMERGENCE OF A NATURAL ARISTOCRACY OF VIRTUOUS CIVIL SERVANTS THE FOUNDERS WOULD SEE THE FAULT OF TODAY S FEDERAL BUREAUCRACY ARGUES RICHARDSON NOT AS MUCH IN ITS SIZE AS IN THE CHARACTER OF ITS MEMBERS RICHARDSON RELATES THE FOUNDERS BELIEF THAT THE NATION SHOULD STRIVE TO PRODUCE PUBLIC SERVANTS COMMITTED TO DEVELOPING CHARACTER TRAITS SUCH AS WISDOM AND MODERATION THAT WOULD EXEMPLIFY THE HIGHEST IDEALS OF THE REPUBLIC AND THUS ENSURE ITS SURVIVAL THEY ANTICIPATED SOME SELF INTEREST ON THE PART OF ADMINISTRATORS BUT BELIEVED IT WOULD BE HELD IN CHECK BY PUBLIC OPINION AND THE POLITICAL PROCESS TO TEST THE SUCCESS OF THE FOUNDERS IDEAL RICHARDSON EXAMINES BOTH THE CHARACTER OF ADMINISTRATORS AND THE ROLE OF ETHICS IN FORMING THAT CHARACTER HE EXPLORES THE VARIOUS PLANS FOR EDUCATING PUBLIC LEADERS THROUGHOUT AMERICAN HISTORY AND LOOKS AT HOW ATTITUDES TOWARD PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION HAVE CHANGED IN THIS CENTURY FROM WOODROW WILSON S SCIENTIFIC IDEAL TO RECENT PROPOSALS TO DOWNSIZE GOVERNMENT AMONG OTHER SUGGESTIONS RICHARDSON ADVOCATES REFORMING EXISTING INSTITUTIONS BY EMPHASIZING CHARACTER DEMOCRACY BUREAUCRACY AND CHARACTER IS AN EXERCISE IN LEGITIMIZING PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION OFFERING IMPORTANT INSIGHTS INTO THE FOUNDERS THOUGHTS THAT CAN BE APPLIED TO TODAY S DEBATE OVER GOVERNMENT BUREAUCRACY PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION MAY BE PROBLEMATIC BY NATURE OBSERVES RICHARDSON BUT IT IS CRUCIAL TO OUR FORM OF GOVERNMENT THROUGH HIS ANALYSIS WE CAN SEE THAT WHILE BUREAUCRACY AND DEMOCRACY HAVE LONG HAD AN UNEASY RELATIONSHIP NEITHER CAN BE EFFECTIVE UNLESS WE FULLY ASSESS THE PLACE AND PURPOSE OF CHARACTER IN THE AMERICAN REGIME
