The section on complement has been reworked and reconceived, explaining the lectin pathway first, making it easier to teach by placing it into the context of innate recognition. Signaling through other receptors is dealt with wherever appropriate throughout the book. Updated chapter on B cell immune responses. Chapter 12 has been brought up to date, including responses to the commensal microbiota and the role of specialized dendritic cells and the regulatory T cells in maintaining tolerance to food antigens and commensal bacteria. Chapter 16, manipulation of the immune response, has been heavily revised to include a greater emphasis on clinical issues and a complete update of immunotherapeutics and vaccines.
