Abstract: Welfare economics as a multidisciplinary body of knowledge aims at the best way of interpretation of human wellbeing and human endeavor. Classical economists were used dynamic and normative methodologies, while later developments in welfare economics became narrow-minded by following static and positive economics by putting assumptions, mathematical, and other models. Classical theories were influenced in the idea of invisible hand and argue that the social welfare can be enlarged at the point where the highest level of happiness can be enjoyed by maximum number. On the other side, the later developments, especially by later neoclassical theories, began to weaken the role of invisible hand. Moreover, the analysis was based on predicting social welfare by simply assuming two individual model frameworks. Here vividly the scope of modern interpretation became too extreme by neglecting the role of multiple factors of a plural society in the welfare determination process.
