on great thinkers of the past century including luigi giussani dietrich von hildebrand and hans urs von
balthasar fr nepil offers a first ascent a new route where catholic theology meets alpine adventure in his telling
the catholic worldview offers the fullest spiritual vision of the backcountry and the backcountry in turn
reveals itself as a privileged setting for catholic formation seen from the trail the catholic faith comes alive as
an incarnational worldview where we rediscover humanity creation and god this is a rich theological
guidebook for all catholic lovers of the great outdoors particularly the mountains and for all who see and seek
god in the stark majesty of the natural world

afro and indigenous intersectionality in america as nomen broadens the historical narrative of indigenous autochthonous and first world people who have been classified historically as negro black colored afro and african american by addressing the ways in which the singular narrative of slavery codifies identity this work moves beyond binary racial classifications and proposes the possibility of utilizing holistic historical narratives to foster group and personal identity

in the middle of the nineteenth century the russian empire made a dramatic advance on the pacific by annexing the vast regions of the amur and ussuri rivers although this remote realm was a virtual terra incognita for the russian educated public the acquisition of an asian mississippi attracted great attention nonetheless even stirring the dreams of russia s most outstanding visionaries within a decade of its acquisition however the dreams were gone and the amur region largely abandoned and forgotten in an innovative examination of russia s perceptions of the new territories in the far east mark bassin sets the amur enigma squarely in the context of the zeitgeist in russia at the time imperial visions demonstrates the fundamental importance of geographical imagination in the mentalité of imperial russia this 1999 work offers a truly novel perspective on the complex and ambivalent ideological relationship between russian nationalism geographical identity and imperial expansion

abigail l swingen s insightful study provides a new framework for understanding the origins of the british empire while exploring how england s original imperial designs influenced contemporary english politics and debates about labor economy and overseas trade focusing on the ideological connections between the growth of unfree labor in the english colonies particularly the use of enslaved africans and the development of british imperialism during the early modern period the author examines the overlapping often competing agendas of planters merchants privateers colonial officials and imperial authorities in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries

a new anthropology of protestant feminism anchored by the language experiments of one lutheran community the language of the bible is a powerful lens through which many protestants understand themselves and their world and its prohibitions on women s speech pose complicated challenges to women

nevertheless women frequently serve as vocal leaders in protestant organizations including the early twentieth century norwegian mission society in life in language ingie hovland offers a unique biography of henny dons a leader of the society's so called mission feminists that grapples with ways protestant women crafted innovative expansive self understandings through christian language more than their male peers the mission feminists turned to religious speech to express material as well as heavenly desires for paid work voting rights and more and hovland argues that these experiments in women speaking reading writing and listening paved the way for a new way of being in the world

this comprehensive reference offers an authoritative overview of andean lifeways it provides valuable historical context and demonstrates the relevance of learning about the andes in light of contemporary events and debates the volume covers the ecology and pre columbian history of the region and addresses key themes such as cosmology aesthetics gender and household relations modes of economic production exchange and consumption postcolonial legacies identities political organization and movements and transnational interconnections with over 40 essays by expert contributors that highlight the breadth and depth of andean worlds this is an essential resource for students and scholars alike

in visions of deliverance mayte green mercado traces the circulation of muslim and crypto muslim apocalyptic texts known as joferes through formal and informal networks of merchants sufis and other channels of diffusion among muslims and christians across the mediterranean from constantinople and venice to morisco towns in eastern spain the movement of these prophecies from the eastern to the western edges of the mediterranean illuminates strategies of morisco cultural and political resistance reconstructing both productive and oppositional interactions and exchanges between muslims and christians in the early modern mediterranean challenging a historiography that has primarily understood morisco apocalyptic thought as the expression of a defeated group that was conscious of the loss of their culture and identity green mercado depicts moriscos not simply as helpless victims of christian oppression but as political actors whose use of end times discourse helped define and construct their society anew visions of deliverance helps us understand the implications of confessionalization forced conversion and assimilation in the early modern period and the intellectual and theological networks that shaped politics and identity across the mediterranean in this era

this book demonstrates how morocco and other semi arid countries can find solutions to water scarcity by rediscovering traditional methods of water resource management the book begins by examining indigenous water heritage considering the contribution of islam and the mixed influences of greek and roman middle eastern andalusian and berber cultures it then provides a thorough examination of resource management practices in morocco throughout history tracing the changing patterns from the instillation of agrarian capitalism in the 19th century through the protectorate years 1912 1956 to the 21st century the book explains how reviving and modernizing traditional methods of water management could provide simple accessible and successful methods for addressing 21st century challenges such as water scarcity and climate change the work concludes by highlighting how these indigenous practices might be used to provide real world practical solutions for improving water governance and therefore developing sustainable water management practices reviving indigenous water management practices in morocco will be of great interest to students and scholars interested in water resource management indigenous peoples traditional knowledge and sustainable development
