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the romance languages offer a particularly fertile ground for the exploration of the relationship between language and society in different social contexts and communities focusing on a wide range of romance languages from national

languages to minoritised varieties this volume explores questions concerning linguistic diversity and multilingualism language contact medium and genre variation and change it will interest researchers and policy makers alike

the book is dedicated to the linguistic psycholinguistic and ethnolinguistic dimensions of italian as a heritage language spoken by minorities in the americas and europe the contributions deepen our understanding of heritage language bilingualism in general especially by comparing the acquisition of inflectional morphology in italian with the processes at play in other heritage languages

this innovative collection brings together a range of perspectives on the notions of orderly heterogeneity and social meaning shedding light on how structured variation and indexicalities of social meaning cohere within linguistic communities this book fills a gap in research on language variation by critically considering the position articulated by weinrich labov and herzog in 1968 that linguistic diversity is systematically organized in ways that reflect and construct social order the volume investigates such key themes as covariation and co occurrence restrictions indexicality perception and social meaning coherence and language change and the structure and measurement of coherence at different levels of analysis this collection advances our understanding of the coherence of linguistic communities through empirical investigations of larger and more diverse sets of variables language varieties speech styles and communities as afforded by the development and advancement of new methods and models in sociolinguistic research this book is of interest to scholars in sociolinguistics language variation and change and formal linguistics as well as those interested in developments on research methods in linguistics

this volume contains a selection from papers presented at the 9th international conference on language variation in europe iclave 9 which was held at the university of malaga spain from june 6 to 9 2017 the volume includes plenaries by manuel almeida language hybridism on the origin of interdialectal forms and frans hinskens of clocks clouds and sound change in addition the editors have selected 13 papers encompassing different languages and language varieties not only from large language families such as romance and germanic but also small language families like greek or smaller languages like croatian and covering a large range of topics on sociolinguistics and linguistic variation the book displays a contemporary picture of the research currently being conducted on language variation and change in european languages readers interested in every field related to language and language use will enjoy a wide variety of theoretical frameworks and methodological perspectives on speech variation historical sociolinguistics and foreign language acquisition and learning

the city as a complex socio cultural structure plays a central role economically administratively as well as culturally factors such as higher population density a more expansive infrastructure and larger social and cultural diversity compared to rural areas have a substantial impact on urban society and urban communication focusing on the latter the contributions to this volume discuss the characteristics and dynamics of urban language use considering aspects such as contact variation and change as well as identity indexicality and attitudes but also spatial factors including mobility urbanisation counterurbanisation and diffusion processes the collected articles provide an update of first wave approaches of variationist sociolinguistics but also establish a connection to third wave research for readers from a broad range of fields especially sociolinguistics variationist linguistics and dialectology the book presents modern methodological and conceptual ideas and a wealth of new findings but also serves as a reference work combining theoretical discussions with results from recent empirical studies

nel 1865 furono emanate le leggi di unificazione amministrativa del regno d italia in occasione del centocinquantesimo il dipartimento di scienze giuridiche dell università di firenze ha organizzato un progetto di studi sulle trasformazioni che nell ultimo cinquantennio hanno interessato gli apparati e le attività dell amministrazione della repubblica vista nel suo articolato governo locale e nella sua appartenenza all unione europea le ricerche hanno coinvolto nell arco di quasi due anni più di centocinquanta studiosi di università italiane i risultati sono stati presentati il 15 e 16 ottobre del 2015 a firenze la città che centocinquanta anni prima era stata capitale d italia e che nel 1965 aveva ospitato il convegno celebrativo del centenario delle stesse leggi di unificazione amministrativa gli studi condotti sono ora pubblicati in forma definitiva e organizzati in otto volumi piano dell opera i l organizzazione delle pubbliche amministrazioni tra stato nazionale e integrazione europea a cura di roberto cavallo perin aristide police fabio saitta ii la coesione politico territoriale a cura di gabriella de giorgi cezzi pier luigi portaluri iii la giuridificazione a cura di barbara marchetti mauro renna iv la tecnificazione a cura di stefano civitarese matteucci luisa torchia v l intervento pubblico nell economia a cura di maurizio cafagno francesco manganaro vi unità e pluralismo culturale a cura di edoardo chiti gianluca gardini aldo sandulli vii la giustizia amministrativa come servizio tra effettività ed efficienza a cura di gian domenico comporti viii cittadinanze amministrative a cura di antonio bartolini alessandra pioggia

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
