this collection of essays explores the significance of modern chaos theory as a new paradigm in literary studies and argues for the usefulness of borrowings from one discipline to another its thesis is that external reality is real and is not merely a social construct on the other hand this volume reflects the belief that literature as a social and cultural construct is not unrelated to that external reality the authors represented here furthermore believe that learning to communicate across disciplinary divides is worth the risk of looking silly to purists and dogmatists in applying a contemporary scientific grid to a by gone era the authors play out steven weinberg's exhortation to mind the

clues to the past that cannot be obtained in any other way it is of course necessary to get the science right yet the essays in this collection do not seek to do science but rather to suggest that science and literature often share common assumptions and realities thus there is no attempt to legitimize literary study through the adoption of a scientific approach interaction between the disciplines requires mutual respect and a willingness to investigate the broader implications of scientific research consequently this volume will be of interest to students and scholars of the long eighteenth century whether the focus is on england locke milton radcliffe lewis france crébillon diderot marivaux montesquieu or germany kant moritz goethe fr schlegel moreover given its multiple thrust in employing mythological philosophical and scientific notions of chaos this volume will appeal to historians and philosophers of the european enlightenment as well as to literary historians the volume ultimately aspires to promote communication across centuries and across disciplines

my writing career has been at least in this one respect idiosyncratic it had to mark and chart step by step its own peculiar champaign my earliest papers beginning in 1942 were technical articles in this or that domain of uralic linguistics ethnography and folklore with a sprinkling of contributions to north and south american linguistics in 1954 my name became fecklessly associated with psycholinguistics then successively with explorations in my theology religious studies and stylistic problems it now takes special effort for me to even revive the circumstances under which i came to publish in 1955 a hefty tome on the supernatural another in 1958 on games and yet another in 1961 utilizing a computer for extensive sorting of literary information by 1962 i had edged my way into animal communication studies two years after that i first whiffled through what gavin ewart evocatively called the tulgey wood of semiotics in 1966 i published three books which tem porarily bluffed some of my friends into conjecturing that i was about to meta morphose into a historiographer of linguistics the topmost layer in my scholarly stratification dates from 1976 when i started to compile what eventually became my semiotic tetralogy of which this volume may supposably be the last in the language of jabberwocky the word tulgey is said to connote variability and evasiveness this notwithstanding the allusion seems to me apt

in the history of humanity as well as in the brief and recent history of the new paradigms in science we find theories of the way the heavens and the earth are or should be in this book our intention is to examine in depth those that build bridges humanity and consciousness are positioned as the foundation of the human being in the face of those who would reduce him to a genetic robot based on many years of work in the field we are offering a possible doorway to healing as a bridge of knowledge in day to day life so that my masters my patients can receive what they have taught me the magic of transforming an obstacle into a lever this book is therefore both theoretical and practical in order to assist in resolving those painful repetitions of our ancestors lives blind programming and painful wounds with a view to finding a healing path nature s and therefore evolution s secret in which the psychology of complexity serves to reconcile us with life in our afflicted and opportune world
