corporate finance core principles and applications was developed for the graduate mba level as a concise up to date and to the point product the majority of which can be realistically covered in a single term or course to achieve the objective of reaching out to the many different types of students and the varying course settings corporate finance is distilled down to its core while maintaining a decidedly modern approach purely theoretical issues are downplayed and the use of extensive and elaborate calculations is minimized to illustrate points that are either intuitively obvious or of limited practical use the goal was to focus on what students really need to carry away from a principles course a balance is struck by introducing and covering the essentials while leaving more specialized topics to follow up courses net present value is treated as the underlying and unifying concept in corporate finance every subject covered is firmly rooted in valuation and care is taken throughout to explain how particular decisions have valuation effects also the role of the financial manager as decision maker is emphasized and the need for managerial input and judgment is stressed

continuous time models in corporate finance synthesizes four decades of research to show how stochastic calculus can be used in corporate finance combining mathematical rigor with economic intuition santiago moreno bromberg and jean charles rochet analyze corporate decisions such as dividend distribution the issuance of securities and capital structure and default they pay particular attention to financial intermediaries including banks and insurance companies the authors begin by recalling the ways that option pricing techniques can be employed for the pricing of corporate debt and equity they then present the dynamic model of the trade off between taxes and bankruptcy costs and derive implications for optimal capital structure the core chapter introduces the workhorse liquidity management model where liquidity and risk management decisions are made in order to minimize the costs of external finance this model is used to study corporate finance decisions and specific features of banks and insurance companies the book concludes by presenting the dynamic agency model where financial frictions stem from the lack of interest alignment between a firm s manager and its financiers the appendix contains an overview of the main mathematical tools

used throughout the book requiring some familiarity with stochastic calculus methods continuous time models in corporate finance will be useful for students researchers and professionals who want to develop dynamic models of firms financial decisions

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
