engendered by past black experiences has hampered the formation of significant intergroup social capital the book features case studies of school reform activity including the first analysis of the politics surrounding baltimore s decision to hire a private for profit firm to operate nine of its public schools these cases illuminate the paradoxical aspects of black social capital in citywide school reform while offering critical perspectives on current debates about privatization site based management and other reform alternatives orr s book challenges those who argue that social capital alone can solve fundamentally political problems by purely social means and questions the efficacy of either privatization or black community power to reform urban schools black social capital offers a cogent conceptual synthesis of social capital theory and urban regime theory that demonstrates the importance of government politics and leadership in converting social capital into a resource that can be mobilized for effective social change
