when a high school girl is reborn into the world of her favorite novel she s ready for a life of riches romance and a front row seat to the drama the problem she s been reborn as mary bell the villainess of the story to make matters worse she s cursed to continue speaking like the original mary bell every word she utters sounds rude conceited and cruel however just as she decides she ll need to live quietly to avoid her death flags the original heroine of the story aria gets bullied right in front of her with no choice but to step in mary bell decides to make the most of a new unexpected proximity to her beloved main character and singer as her sponsor taking knowledge from her previous life of idols and talent agents mary bell helps aria traverse a world of nameless troupes and mediocre male leads to become beneath a beautiful melody s very first popstar all while avoiding the pitfalls of the original story

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henry wadsworth longfellow s poems are filled with powerful heroines from evangeline the exiled wanderer to vittoria colonna the aging genius of the italian renaissance in the heroines of henry longfellow domestic defiant divine timothy e g bartel provides a survey of longfellow s major heroines placing them in the context of longfellow s body of work and the poet s interests in theology politics and history though longfellow s heroines have sometimes been dismissed as mere domestic caricatures bartel argues

that longfellow s heroines are nothing of the sort instead they provide us with unique pictures of how one s individual talents and desires can be harmonized with the christian ideals of communal justice ethical living and ultimate union with the divine

other words it has been sought to allow the original author to tell his own story over again in his own language but in the shortest possible space however we are aware that even the world s greatest books will not escape the criticism of a small class of people who will profess to object to this as to any kind of interference with an author s original in reply to which it can only be said that such objections are seldom if ever made in the true interests of learning or in a genuine spirit of inquiry and too often only proceed from a knowledge of books or love of them which goes no deeper than their title page the selections in the world s greatest books have been collected and are alphabetically arranged in ten different divisions namely fiction lives and letters history religion philosophy economics science poetry and drama travel and adventure and miscellaneous literature an important additional feature of the work is the brief yet highly critical biographical and bibliographical note which accompanies every author and every selection throughout the twenty volumes to this must be also added the not less important introductions and other explanations written by experts which often accompany the selections in the text cardinal examples of which will be found in particular in the section of religion of this work in the articles dealing with such subjects as the book of the dead brahmanism confucianism the koran talmud etc
