

Letters To A Diminished Church

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what must a person believe to be a christian in this collection of 16 essays famed author dorothy l sayers discusses why the church desperately needs to refocus on doctrine as doctrine impacts all of life in her dynamic and sharp writings dorothy l sayers turned the popular perception of christianity on its head she argues that the essence of christianity is in the character of christ energetic dramatic and utterly alive this collection of sixteen brilliant essays reveals sayers at her best a powerful view of christianity as startling and relevant as it was 50 years ago an outspoken defender of christian orthodoxy dorothy l sayers discusses christian theology with brilliance and wit a british scholar author and staunch christian sayers brings theology vividly to life by showing how the bible history literature and modern science fit together to make religion not only possible but necessary in our time each essay is a concise perceptive examination of the topic at hand the book includes sixteen essays on a variety of topics addressing core beliefs the image of god the problem of sin and evil and more presents age old doctrines without prettifying them up or watering them down provides insights into the social and spiritual forces that affect the modern day cultural shift away from christ whether you are reading the great works of western literature thinking about your place in god s universe or simply dealing with the thousand and one problems of daily living this powerful book has words of both challenge and comfort for you the devil should stand alert for sayers is one of his foremost adversaries

worlds of common prayer explores book length poems based on the anglican liturgical calendar written between 1827 and 1935 john keble created a new type of english poetry when he wrote his poetic companion to the book of common prayer the christian year 1827 which went on to become the single bestselling book of poetry in the english century drawing off of recent scholarship on both secularization studies and nineteenth century conceptions of time worlds of common prayer exposes the surprisingly radical potential of liturgical poetry the detective novelist and poet dorothy l sayers wrote of her desire to find a brick that could smash the order of clock time and discovered one in the liturgy for major authors as dissimilar as christina rossetti and t s eliot the anglican liturgical calendar served as a means of dismantling industrial capitalism s time clock and thereby of destabilizing the secular world order as a whole

once one nation under god america today is desperately sick and the church seems to have no answers how can a nation so churched be so untouched by the gospel why has the glory departed leaving a nation racked by political hatred drug addiction and shattered families god

caesar and idols asks these questions and calls the church to seek god's word for answers too many christians no longer make political choices on the basis of eternal truth but instead make them on the basis of purely financial considerations it's time for the church to break its addiction to humanistic government schooling and instead bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the lord this book challenges the church to reject cheap grace and the easy temptation to be tolerant of society's rebellion we must again honor the authority of god's word and embrace the life altering power available when we reject our cultural idols and proclaim the whole counsel of god without compromise armed with careful scriptural exegesis and supported by the words of great christians from church history god caesar and idols encourages the american church to again contend for the faith in today's culture whatever the cost

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jean jacques von allmen's work was animated by three key insights the church both learns and becomes what it truly is when it gathers to worship worship tells the story of god's salvation history and invites god's people into it and by doing so the church offers the world both a stern warning and a hopeful promise the swiss reformed pastor and professor is among the most admired liturgical theologians of the twentieth century but his work is largely and lamentably unknown to most worship leaders in church at church ron rienstra provides an introduction to this important thinker he offers methodological and biographical context and then explores von allmen's most generative insights concerning the church as it engages in its most foundational activity worship viewed through the lens of the nicene marks rienstra's exploration yields the outlines of a liturgical ecclesiology a way to help the church think more deeply about its identity and to help its leaders shape the worship they prepare and lead today

when you look at the world what do you see as an artist your creativity stems from your vision the problem in the modern world is how often one's imagination is fragmented and reduced between worship and work the body and soul the material and the spiritual written to practicing artists and those who pastor them the artistic vision encourages artists who long for a greater sense of purpose and a greater sense of wholeness proposing that seeing the material world as a shadow of spiritual realities will lead them toward an expression that joins faith and practice drawing from the oxford movement and artistic examples like christina rosetti and flannery o connor ball and sosler present a sacramental way of seeing the world the invisible through the visible the spiritual through the material the divine through creation interspersed with practical vignettes from artists and pastoral reflection the artistic vision helps artists regain an enchanted mysterious and reverent vision of life artists neither have to check their faith at the studio door nor produce kitschy or easy art by creating with a sacramental vision they are seeing the world charged with the grandeur of god and inviting viewers into that participation

for centuries the belief that god was directly engaged in our individual lives has comforted untold numbers of people but today that belief is being challenged by many within the community of faith the randomness of violence innocent suffering and inexplicable evil has pushed believers to question whether god is personal in any meaningful way how can we believe that god is involved in our daily lives when so often god appears deaf to our prayers and indifferent to our broken world we in the shadow explores how or in what way god may be personal unless this question can somehow be thoughtfully and practically answered faith will be viewed as an option only for those who skim over the incomprehensibly cruel surfaces of life with eyes closed and fingers stuck firmly in their ears

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
