1930 he navigated scores of previously unmapped rivers traversed untraversed mountain ranges and hacked his way through jungles so inhospitable that even native peoples had avoided them and led theodore roosevelt and his son kermit on their celebrated river of doubt journey in 1913 14 upon leaving the brazilian army in 1930 with the rank of a two star general rondon himself of indigenous descent devoted the remainder of his life to not only writing about the region's flora and fauna but also advocating for the peoples who inhabited the rainforest and lobbying for the creation of a system of national parks despite his many achievements which include laying down a 1 200 mile telegraph line through the heart of the amazon and three nominations for the nobel peace prize rondon has never received his due originally published in brazil into the amazon is the first comprehensive biography of his life and remarkable career
