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native scholars explore the relationship between political parties and democracy in regions around the world the development of political parties over the past century is the story of three stages in the pursuit of power liberation democratization and de democratization political parties and democracy is comprised of five stand alone volumes that probe the realities of political parties at all three stages in each volume contributors explore the relationship between political parties and democracy or democratization in their nations providing necessary historical socioeconomic and institutional context as well as the details of contemporary political tensions contributors are distinguished indigenous scholars who have lived the truths they tell and are thus able to write with unique breadth depth and scope they show the parties of their respective nations as they have developed through

history and changing institutional structures and they explain the balance of power among them and between them and competing agencies of power today

inter ethnic inter sectional relations attempts to perpetuate the tenure of chief executives through constitutional amendments and developments in electoral politics and conflicts the book provides incisive analysis into these issues

since the 1980s political scientists have developed a renewed interest in the study of political institutions based on the assumption that institutions matter that is that formal governmental institutions and constitutional legal rules as well as informal institutions like parties and interest groups are crucial determinants of the shape of politics and policy outcomes in this respect the new institutionalism resembles the old institutionalism of pre behaviorist days but the crucial difference between the two is that the new institutionalists are committed to systematic empirical testing of their hypotheses at least in principle in practice however especially in comparative analyses this goal has often been frustrated by the lack of reliable data for a large number of countries researchers have therefore usually been limited to testing their hypotheses with modest data sets collected for their own particular purposes of all of the political institutions the executive branch of the government is by far the most important it can be regarded as the irreducible core of government and the principal embodiment of political authority with specific powers that are not lodged elsewhere in the political system almost all countries in the world and certainly all modern democracies have an executive body called government cabinet or administration as in the term the clinton administration that has the main responsibility for running the country's public affairs

this book explores the paradox of the worldwide spread of democracy and capitalism in an era of western decline the rest is overtaking the west as samuel huntington predicted but because it is adopting western institutions the emerging global order offers unprecedented opportunities for the expansion of peace prosperity and freedom yet this is not the end of history but the beginning of a post western future for the democratic project the major conflicts of the future will occur between the established democracies of the west and emerging democracies in the developing world as they seek the benefits and recognition associated with membership of the democratic community this clash of democratizations will define world politics

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
