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historically and culturally the societies that produced still life painting could hardly be more diverse what is it then that allows us to place such different types of image in a

single category norman bryson argues that the family resemblances between the different types of still life stem from their common portrayal of a level of material culture that retains its fundamental outlines through long spans of time and across the boundaries and divisions of national culture the culture of domestic routine and the rituals of hospitality how this low plane reality is historically viewed and inflected by the higher levels and discourses of the surrounding culture is the fundamental subject of this book

in essays on the pleasure of death ellie ragland discusses the interconnection of freud and lacan s theories while maintaining that crucial differences between them still exist ragland argues however that lacan s return to freud gave coherence to concepts which freud could never explain psychosis narcissism the body and the death drive drawing upon lacan s untranslated seminars through 1981 ragland analyzes his theories of the death drive and the concept of jouissance the driving force behind language and libido along with her examination of lacanian theories about the body meaning systems and how they shape reality ragland also discusses the ethical problems of psychoanalysis and the ways in which lacan s work points to the inadequacies of terms like sexuality and gender

essays on music art pop culture literature and politics by the renowned essayist and observer of contemporary life now collected together for the first time the uncollected essays of elizabeth hardwick is a companion collection to the collected essays a book that proved a revelation of what for many had been an open secret that elizabeth hardwick was one of the great american literary critics and an extraordinary stylist in her own right the thirty five pieces that alex andriesse has gathered here none previously featured in volumes of hardwick s work make it clear that her powers extended far beyond literary criticism encompassing a vast range of subjects from new york city to faye dunaway from wagner s parsifal to leonardo da vinci s inventions and from the pleasures of summertime to grits souffl  in these often surprising always well wrought essays we see hardwick s passion for people and places her politics her thoughts on feminism and her ability especially from the 1970s on to write well about seemingly anything

approaches abound to help us beneficially enjoyably read fiction poetry and drama here for the first time is a book that aims to do the same for the essay g douglas atkins performs sustained readings of more than twenty five major essays explaining how we can appreciate and understand what this currently resurgent literary form reveals about the art of living atkins s readings cover a wide spectrum of writers in the english language and his readings are themselves essays gracefully written engaged and engaging atkins starts with the earliest british practitioners of the form

including francis bacon john dryden alexander pope and samuel johnson transcendentalist writers henry david thoreau and ralph waldo emerson are included as are works by americans james baldwin zora neale hurston and e b white atkins also provides readings of a number of contemporary essayists among them annie dillard scott russell sanders and cynthia ozick many of the readings are of essays that atkins has used successfully in the classroom with undergraduate and graduate students for many years in his introduction atkins offers practical advice on the specific demands essays make and the unique opportunities they offer especially for college courses the book ends with a note on the writing of essays furthering the author s contention that reading should not be separated from writing reading essays continues in the tradition of such definitive texts as understanding poetry and understanding fiction throughout atkins reveals the joy delight grace freedom and wisdom of the glorious essay

richard ellmann s scholarly work is notable for its striking liveliness and clarity and its genuine illumination of the writers and works with which he dealt his life of james joyce published in 1959 received more commendation and critical praise than any previous literary biography

a contradictory sort of fellow will durant in his congenial the story of philosophy describes bertrand russell as resolved to be hard headed because he knows he can not be this is a bit unfair as it doesn t really take into account russell s philosophy merely the man but the two are so hard to separate basically russell believes that mysticism is the inspirer of what is best in man but that it is absolutely muddle headed and has lead mankind down numerous philosophic blind alleys in the past thousand or so years he was a mathematical genius wrote prose that could cut like a razor blade concerning the most abstruse subjects in a manner understandable to most laymen and was a profound skeptic in re matters religious this latter got him into all kinds of trouble with women s societies and the like back in the earlier part of the century and actually got him fired from the city college of new york so he packed his bags and went to teach at harvard you see he was a british aristocrat an earl and all this rabble rousing by the hoi polloi was really a non issue for him in his autobiography he recounts how his mother always told him never follow a crowd to do evil russell never followed a crowd to do anything all this biographical elaboration is to help readers understand the man who wrote this book which in a nutshell praises the mystical impulse in its pure unadulterated form while deploring the aforementioned philosophical muddles to which it leads and on the other hand glorifies justly the english schools of empirical logic and the scientific progress to which they have lead one can hardly look at this computer screen and deny this claim all this in a lucid and thoroughly enjoyable prose yes russell has seen his days of celebrity come and go as well as his days in general one might add but if you chance by a wizened looking professor loaded down with heavyweight tomes on metaphysical systems you might get a rather surprising response if you mention bertie russell in his day russell was the mick jagger of philosophy and coeds used to quarrel over who got to bed down with him that night when he came to lecture that the stuff a good proportion of their professors were teaching was quite literally nonsense and just think he got away with it all what fun

russell explains his theory of logical atomism in 10 brilliant essays which include popular treatments of religious and educational issues as well as more technical examinations of problems of logic

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
