this book is the first scholarly edition of the most popular native american captivity narrative published in eighteenth century britain in this fully annotated modern version timothy j shannon re acquaints modern readers with the narrative and its scottish protagonist he tells the story of peter williamson a native of aberdeen who claimed he was kidnapped into indentured servitude in north america lived as a captive among native americans there and then fought as a soldier in the seven years war until he was taken prisoner by the french after returning to britain williamson peddled his tale while wearing native american dress and he eventually settled in edinburgh

in 1758 peter williamson dressed as an indian peddled a tale in scotland about being kidnapped as a young boy sold into slavery and servitude captured by indians and made a prisoner of war separating fact from fiction timothy shannon illuminates the curiosity about america among working class people on the margins of empire

the collections of the advocates library with the exception of its legal books and manuscripts were given by the advocates to the national library of scotland in 1925

whiteness became a legal category that signaled privilege trafficking and race remained tightly interwoven those advocating for the value of whiteness invoked emotionally freighted victimhood claiming that so called white slavery was a crime whose costs far exceeded those associated with the enslavement of african peoples across the americas peck helps us understand the chilling history that produced the racist ideology that still poisons our politics in the present day
