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this book explores the contemporary phenomenon of forced marriage and honour killings in Britain set against a background of increasing honour based violence within the country's South Asian and Muslim diasporas. The book traces the development of the honour question over the past two decades. It accordingly witnesses unprecedented changes in public awareness and government policy including ground breaking honour specific legislation and the criminalisation of forced marriage all of which makes Britain an important context for the study of this now indigenous and self perpetuating social problem. In considering the scale of the challenge and its underlying causes attention is paid to the intersections of gendered power structures that disadvantage female members of honour cultures as well as feminist theories that seek to explain them. The book features five key case studies of honour killings and draws from a wide range of narratives including those of honour violence survivors, grassroots service providers and legislators. Such a myriad of perspectives reveals the complexity of the honour issue and the deep ideological divisions that characterise it. With the UK's multiculturalist discourse unable to reconcile protecting patriarchal minority cultures with safeguarding gender equality and human rights the book raises fundamental questions about the country's future direction following a long trend of state sponsored integrationist policies. The government's response to the honour question points decisively in the direction of a post multicultural British nation.

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The book is aimed at all those studying on foundation degrees in supporting primary and early years teaching and learning and particularly those working at levels 4 and 5. It is written in an accessible style with a focus on work based professional development and encourages critical reflection throughout. It starts with a discussion of reflective practice and includes helpful guidance on developing effective study skills. for many years government policy has associated young people being neet not in education employment or training with educational underachievement worklessness generational poverty poor health antisocial behaviour and reduced life expectancies researchers and policymakers continue to debate whether young people become neet as a result of their own choices i e their personal agency or as a result of external factors i e

social political and economic structures most recognise that the truth is somewhere between the two but a clear understanding of how each interacts in causing young people to become neet has so far been elusive making the development of effective policy and practice problematic agency structure and the neet policy problem makes headway against this problem through an original approach that draws on social cognitive theory and the lived experiences of young people themselves investigating the lives of neet young people between the ages of 17 21 in london this book elucidates the interactions between agency and structure that lead to them becoming neet and in doing so offers a new perspective on the phenomenon it offers a valuable critique of existing policy providing both breadth and detail on the factors affecting the trajectories of young people in their transitions to continued education training or employment it offers a way forward for all who are interested in developing supporting and implementing a revitalised approach to neet policy and practice and a framework around which a coherent multidisciplinary approach to addressing neet could be developed

the turn of the 20th century was a time of great change in britain the empire saw its global influence waning and its traditional social structures challenged there was a growing weariness of industrialism and a desire to rediscover tradition and the roots of english heritage a new interest in english folk song and dance inspired art music which many believed was seeing a renaissance after a period of stagnation since the 18th century this book focuses on the lives of seven composers ralph vaughan williams gustav holst ernest moeran george butterworth philip heseltine peter warlock gerald finzi and percy grainger whose work was influenced by folk songs and early music each chapter provides an historical background and tells the fascinating story of a musical life

a green economy must be built on green jobs the kind of employment that is low carbon intended to reduce energy use and expected to restore environmental quality but attempts to define exactly what a green job is have led to varied and often contradictory answers there are many unresolved questions including whether we consider jobs in the nuclear fuel industry to be green jobs or is a worker at a glass making company which supplies the glass for the solar photovoltaic industry doing a green job given that glass making is a dirty industry this book deals with the relationship between green concepts green jobs green economy green growth and sustainable development it examines to which extent creation of green jobs supports overall economic development as opposed to creation of elitist jobs and greenwashing in order to do so general conceptual frameworks for green jobs green economy green growth and green policy are presented as well as their implementation in ten countries selected among the group of twenty the selection includes advanced the european union the united states of america australia canada republic of korea japan and developing countries mexico china turkey and brazil the analysis presented in this book shows that although green concept is well intentioned its implementation depends on local circumstances economic political and social developed countries perceive green growth as a way to create new markets and demand while developing countries rely more on labor intensive growth and less expensive green jobs thus greening the economy does not diminish differences between rich and poor this book is suitable for those who study and work in ecological economics sustainable development and labor economics

drawing upon a range of resources of critique including critical realist social theory realist international relations theory the sociology of globalization the marxist critique of imperialism and dependency theory this book is an essential contribution to the critical understanding of nationalism and imperialism in the global age it conducts a sustained and in depth analysis of the relations between the asymmetry in the distribution of economic resources and powers of command and the recent play of political events

involving imperialist wars including the russo ukrainian and israeli hamas wars crucially the author argues that establishing these connections requires theorizing political economy in the so called global age as comprised of neoimperial and neoliberal orders as such the book offers a new interpretation of the relations between neoliberalism and neoimperialism and between modes of organizing social relations and resulting global disorders and instabilities this will therefore be of interest to researchers scholars and students working at the intersection of global political economy international relations and the sociology of globalization
