collections of photographs of the town that were taken in various years from 1880 to 1960 as well as chapters on specific people places and events the fourth volume in the series is about the overall structure of the history of the town it divides the 350 year history into four phases settlers main street commerce bradley field area commerce and residential community this volume volume ii has 42 chapters 360 pages and approximately 500 old photos of windsor locks
