stained glass is one of the glories of medieval art and much of the finest glass can be found in england intensely moving in its beauty startling in its colours and fascinating in its imagery it has for centuries captivated visitors to churches and cathedrals this book presents the masterpieces of english stained glass as never seen before covering the entire golden age from 1100 to 1530 it reveals in astonishing new detail over one hundred windows and panels spanning the regions and showing that one never has to travel far to see something special nothing significant is omitted and the most important monuments including the cathedrals of canterbury wells and lincoln as well as york minster among many others are covered in extra depth for the interested visitor the passionate devotee or anybody simply enchanted by these fragile works of art english stained glass will inform enchant and delight
