the ranking of the results of the study using the results adduced from the study a main contractor subcontractor non contractual partnering model was developed the study established that the relationship between main contractors and subcontractors in zambia is poor therefore needing attention interface problems were caused by payment issues poor communication unexpected price escalations and poor construction work in order to address interface problems the study found that there was need for better communication between the parties timely payments and subcontractors access to labour and machinery however the study had some limitations that need consideration when interpreting the results found the limitations included scarcity of specific literature on subcontracting in the zambian construction industry the size of the sample only being limited to lusaka nevertheless these limitations could be addressed through further studies
