discerns an evolutionary narrative deutsch tells a story of retrogression erikson names his epigenesis and gilligan continues in that vein horney s discussion recalls sexual selection stoller s and chodorow s theorizing brings artificial selection to mind and finally in klein s work hughes sees a story of natural selection and adds to it her own notion of multiple gender identities
