use of historical precedent are again becoming important however that interest has not led to new approaches to the subject nor have its bases been examined this i try to do in so doing i discuss a more rigorous and i would argue a more valid way of looking at historical data and hence of using such data in a theory of the built environment and as precedent in environmental design underlying this is my view of environment behavior studies cebs as an emerging theory rather than as data to help design based on current theory although this will be the subject of another book a summary statement of this position may be useful
